






Is international migration becoming more or less feminized?

Percentage of females among all international migrants, 2000 and 2019










Most regions host a comparable number of male and females migrants

Percentage of females among all international migrants, by region of destination, 2000 and 2019










Further disaggregating the data by region can help clarify the global trend

Number of international migrants, by sex and region of destination, 2000 to 2019 (millions)









We can drill down further to see where the migrants live...

Countries hosting the largest numbers of male and female migrants, 2019 (millions)










... and where they come from

Major bilateral corridors of international migrant stock, by sex, 2019 (millions)








Females migrants tend to be over-represented at older ages

Percentage of international migrants, by age and sex, 2019










Disaggregating the data by region reveals a more nuanced picture

Median age among international migrants, by sex and region of destination, 2019










Data availability and the need for capacity building

Evidence-based policies are common


Percentage of Governments that reported having measures to promote evidence-based migration policies, by region, 2019



- □ A mechanism to ensure that migration policy is informed by data, appropriately disaggregated
- An annual national report on migration that includes migration data collected by the Government and/or other sources
 Based on 111 countries with available data (as of 1 September 2019).
