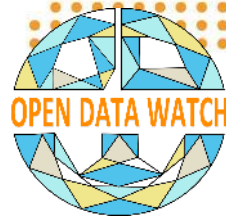

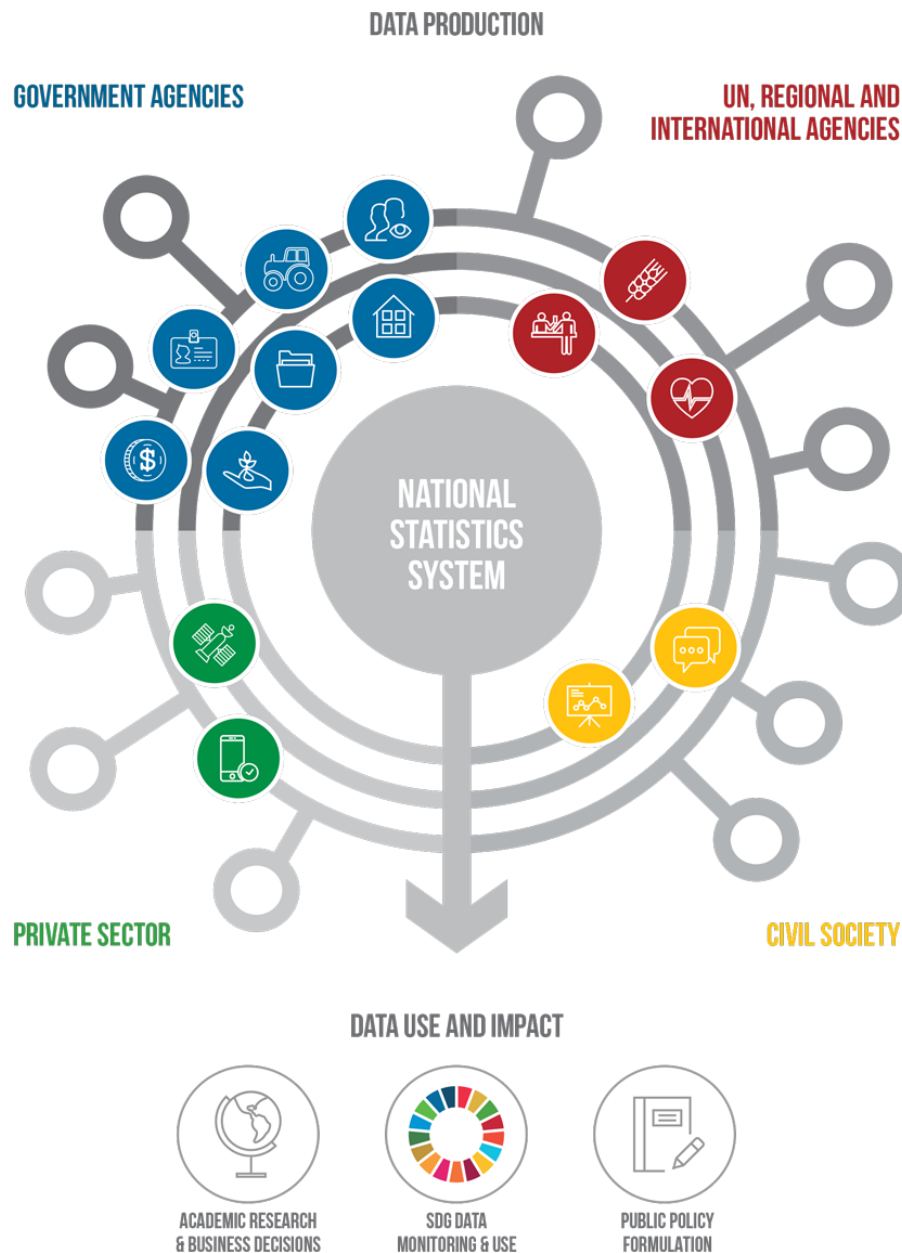

SDG DATA PRODUCTION ECOSYSTEM



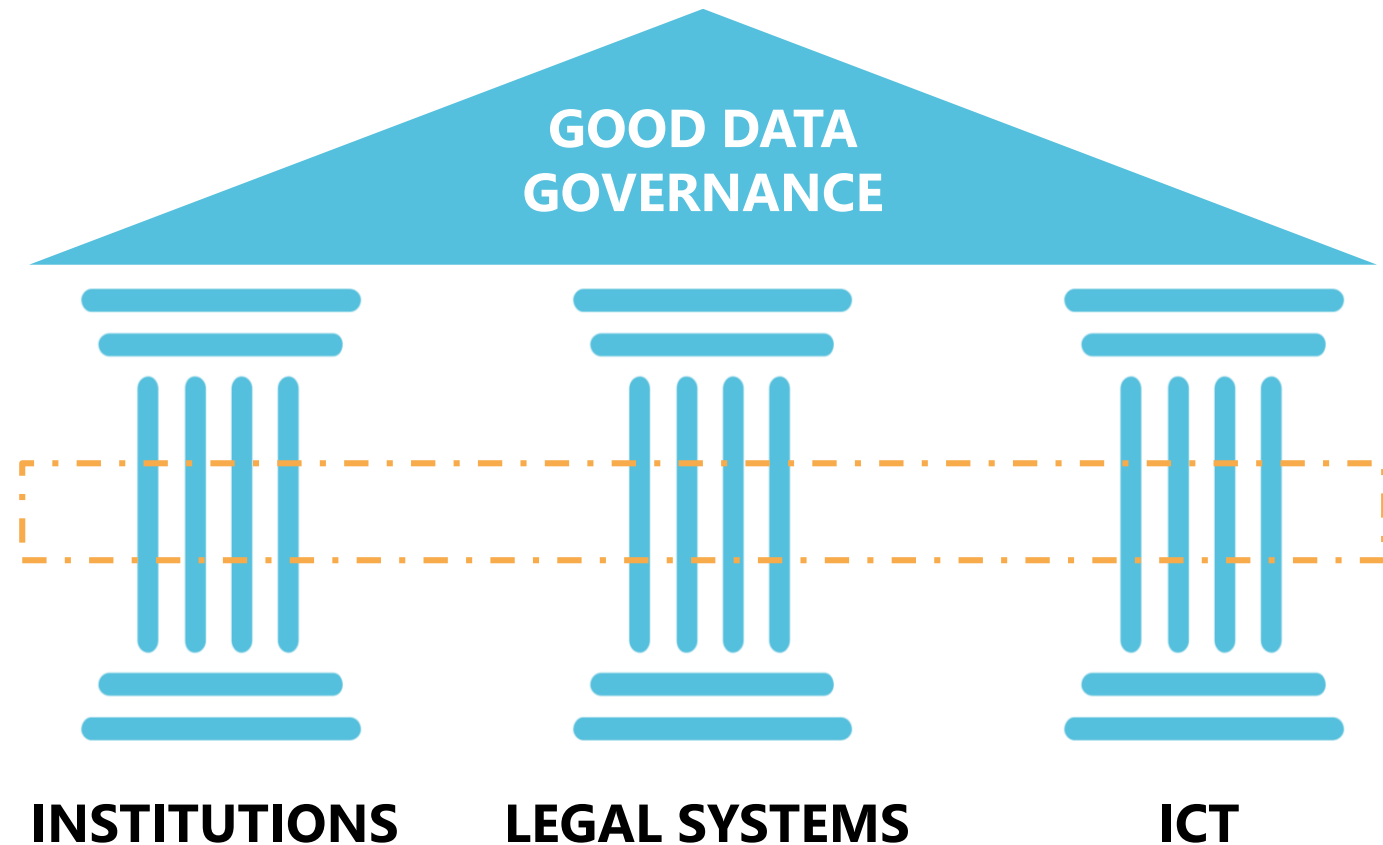

What is our working definition of data governance?



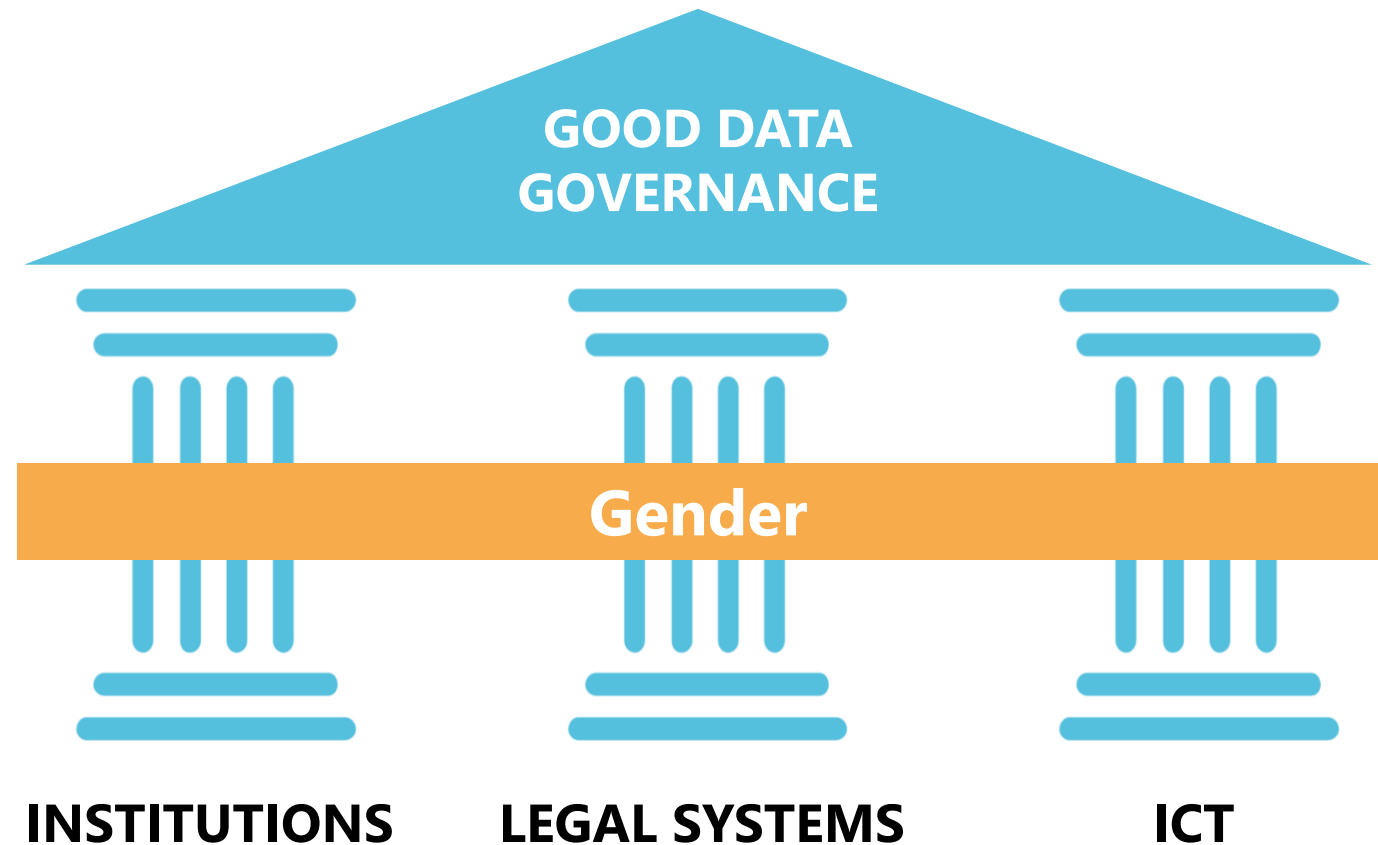

 - Canada, Kenya

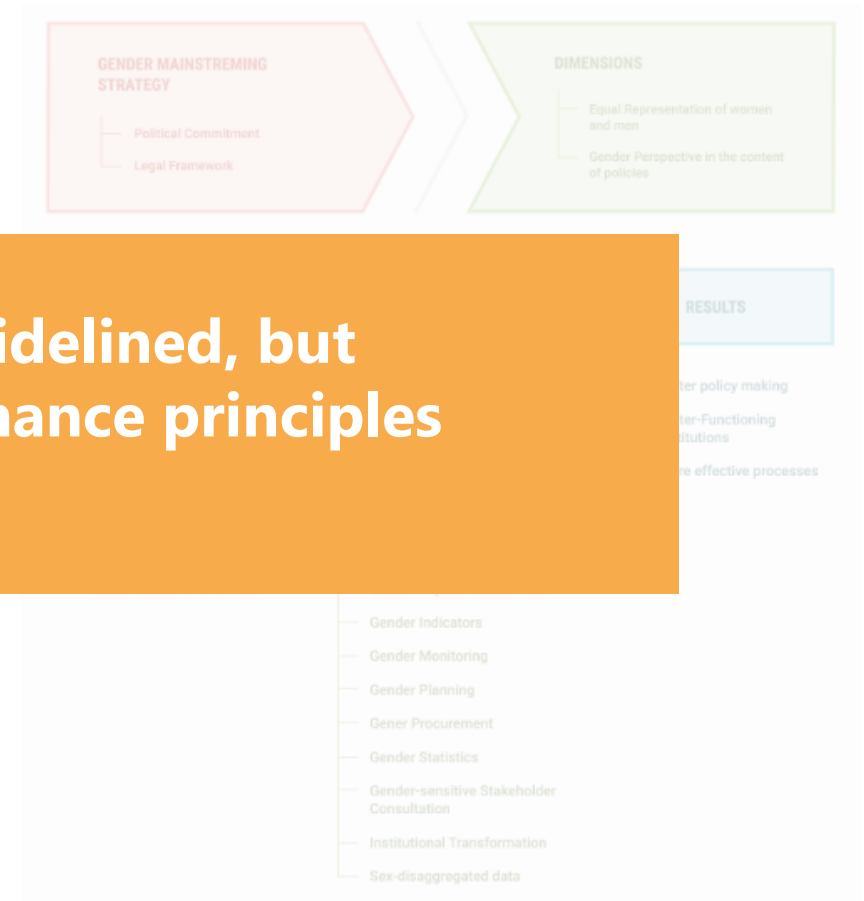


Build on existing and emerging data governance

- National best practices:
 - Canada, Kenya?

Gender should not be excluded or sidelined, but integrated as part of these data governance principles and frameworks





How to increase the impact of gender data

- Invest in and work with foundational systems, such as CRVS
- Incorporate new data sources and partners
 - Include administrative, big data, qualitative and quantitative data
 - Public-Private Partnerships
- Balanced approach to use and misuse (Don't make risk the enemy of value)
- Mainstream gender data along the data value chain

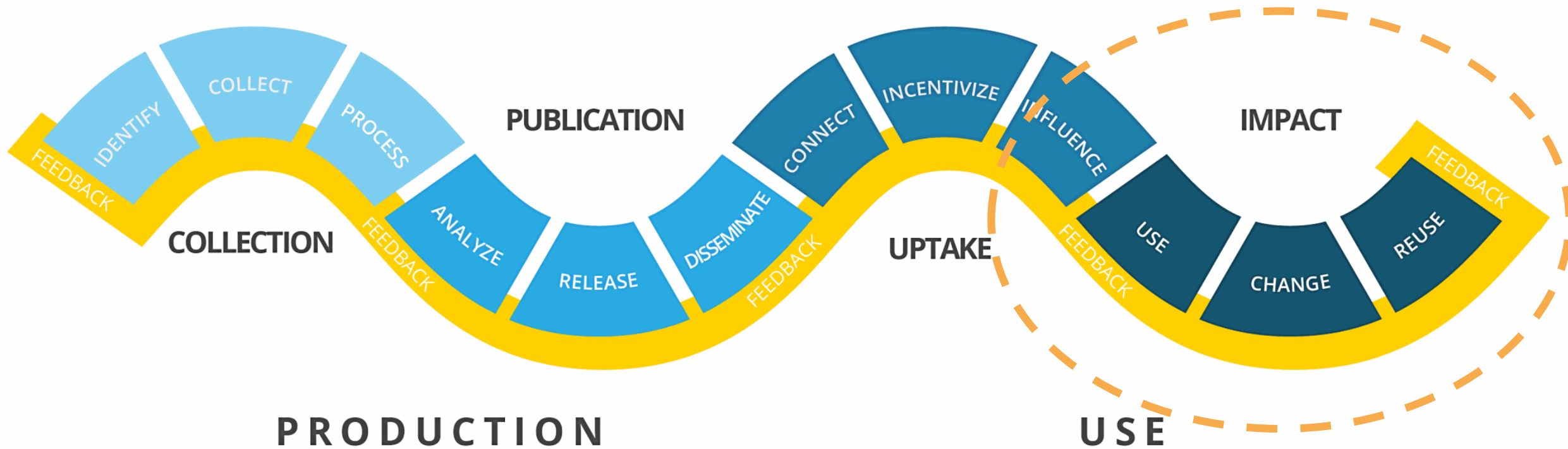


How to increase the impact of gender data (cont.)

- Need for realistic and proportionate financing and capacity building plan
 - Including thinking about representation at all levels of data production and use
- Include last-mile considerations around use, reuse, and feedback
 - M&E
 - Open Data
- Ensure inclusion and participation of women in data governance decision-making processes
