







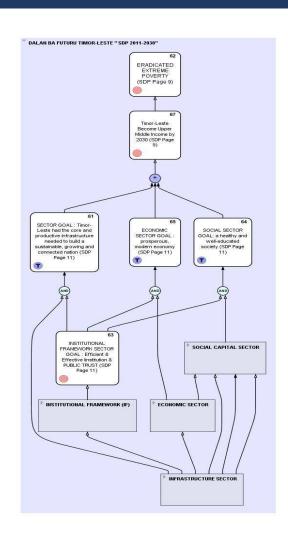

### WHAT IS "DALAN BA FUTURU TIMOR-LESTE (DBFTL)"?

- DBFT is a tool/instrument of Planning, Monitoring and Evaluation which is used for the elaboration of annual plan, monitoring and tracking the implementation of annual plans and evaluate the results to know where we are in terms of the achievement;
- DBFTL shows the changes/ cause and effect from one result (OUTCOME) to another result based on the sequence (DALAN), to achieve the general objective (GOAL) in the FUTURE.
- DBFTL is a "web-based application" which was developed using an "Open Source" platform, no cost license (free);
- DBFTL developed by Timorese, Government Property, therefore there
  will be no cost to use this system and access can be extend to the
  level of villages;
- DBFTL is hosting in Government Datacenter TIC- Timor in terms of security, however this app administrated by UPMA





#### WHY THIS TOOL "DALAN BA FUTURU TIMOR-LESTE"

- 1. DBFTL is one of the component of Public Finance Management reform in the area of Planning, monitoring and Evaluation;
- 2. It is the initiative of the government to digitalize planning, monitoring and evaluation process, with the objective to interface DBFTL to FMIS-Freebalance in an integrated way;
- 3. Part of Program budgeting implementation reform;
- 4. DBFTL develop to facilitate: elaboration of budget in short term-medium term and long term;
- Facilitate planning preparation in an efficient and effective way,
- 6. Monitoring and tracking of annual plan implementation;
- 7. Facilitate information for evaluation and provides actual information for decision makers.

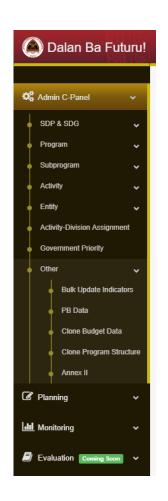

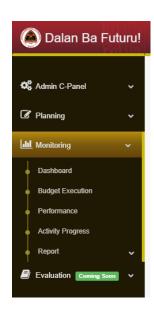

  - 5. Public: Everyone, Dos, CSO, Private Sector

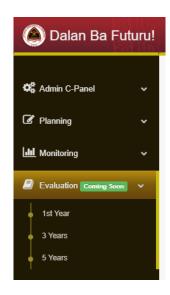

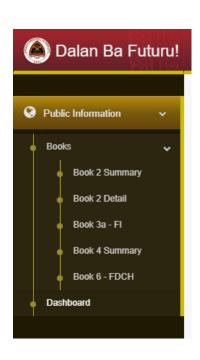








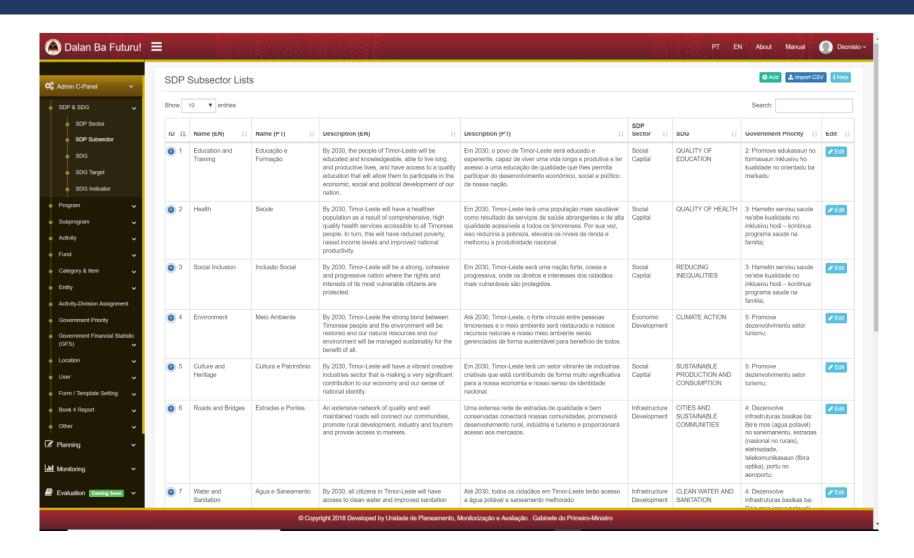

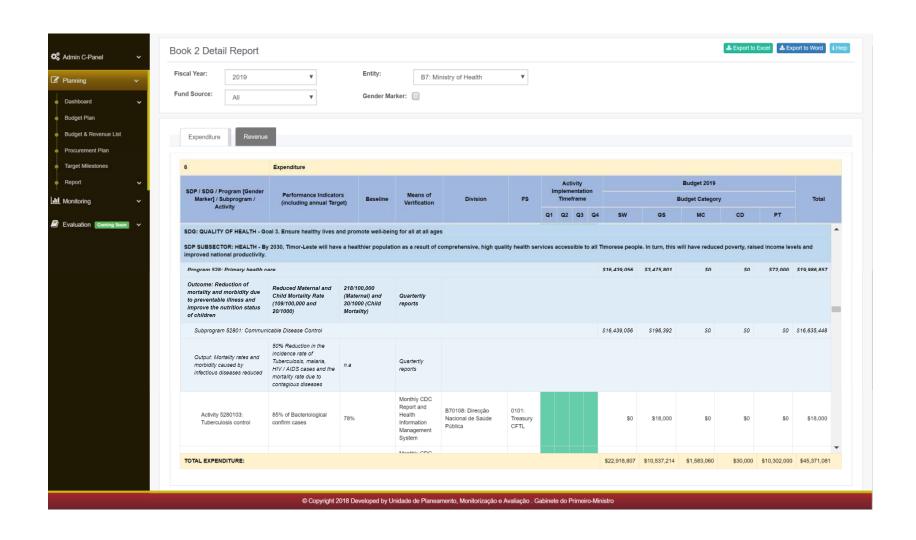


#### SDP 2011-2030 & SDG 2030 ALIGNMENT & MAPPING TO GOVERNMENT PRIORITIES IN DBFT





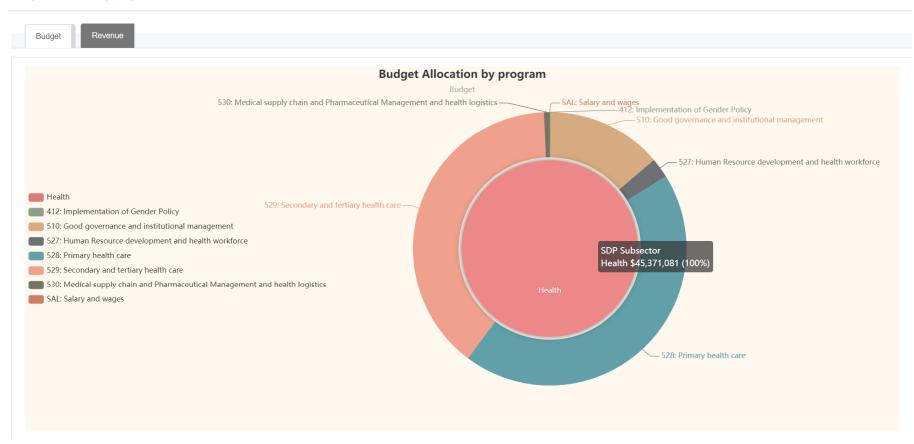
### FINANCING SDP & SDG TARGET: EXAMPLE: MINISTRY OF HEALTH ANNUAL PLAN SDG 3





### BUDGET ALLOCATION TO SDP SUB-SECTOR HEALTH

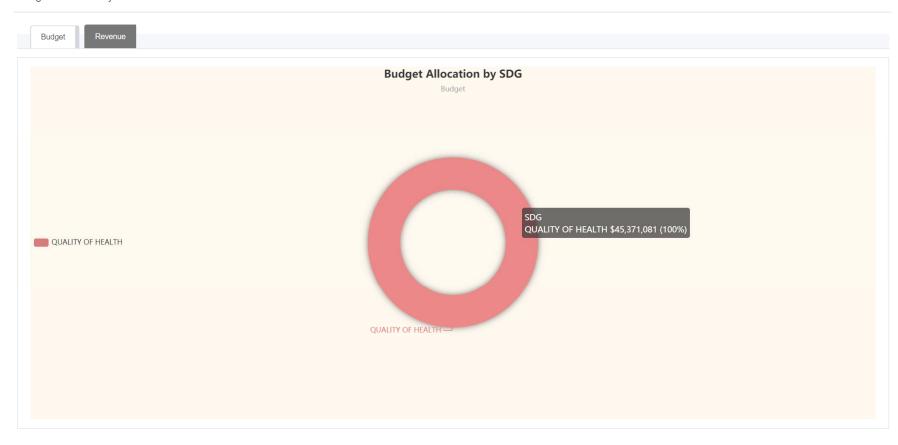
#### Budget Allocation by program





## TOTAL BUDGET OF MINISTRY OF HEALTH TO SDG 3 FINANCING

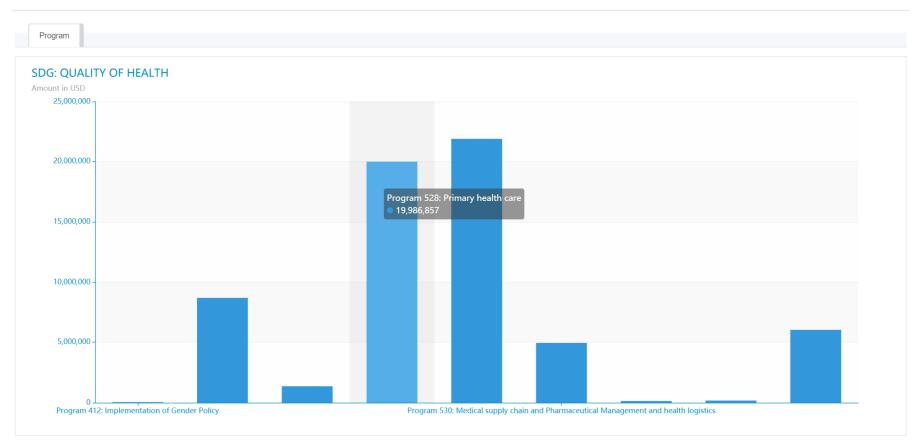
