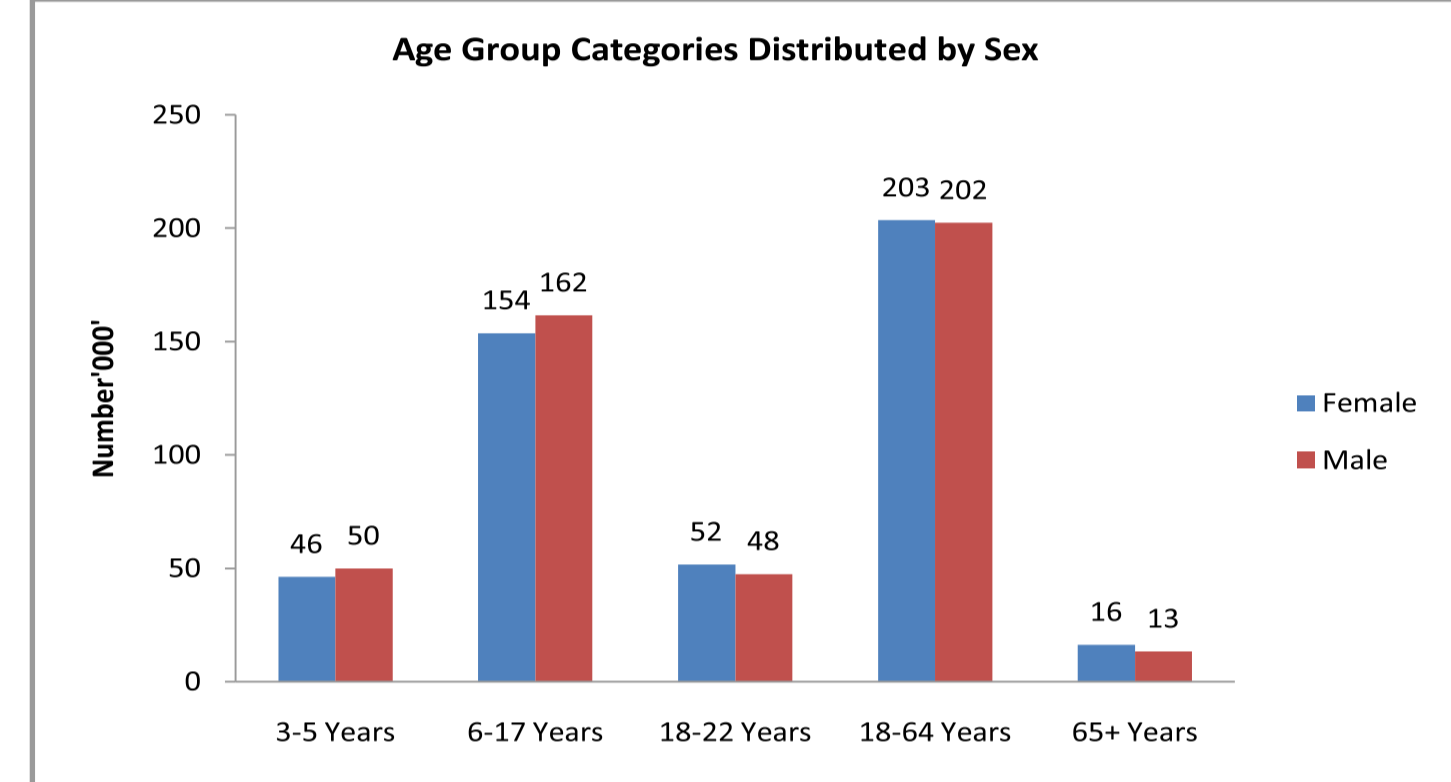

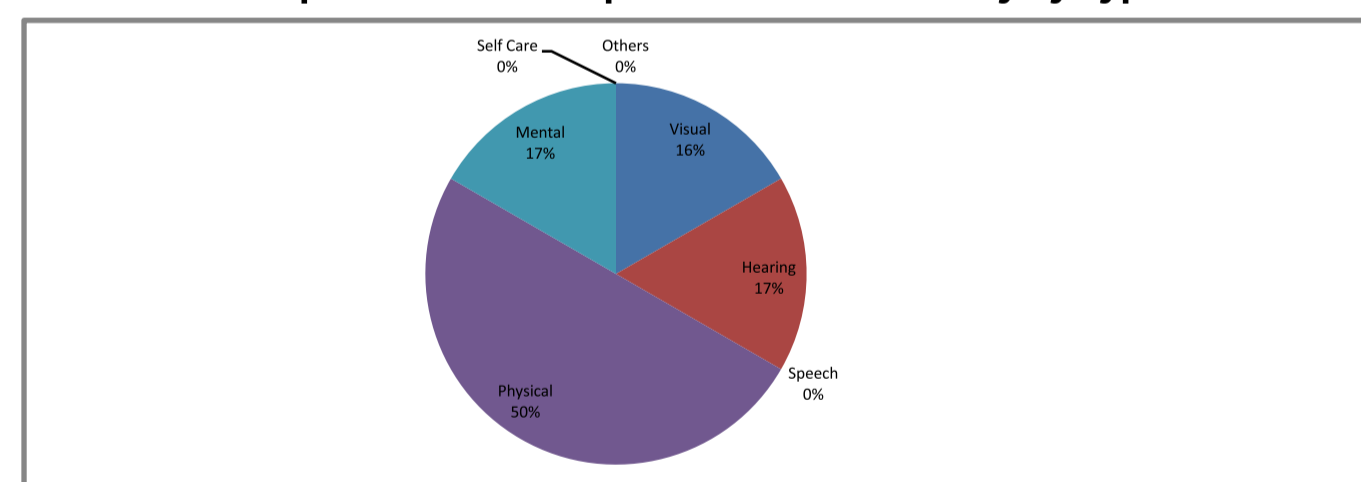

Proportion of the Population with Disability by Type



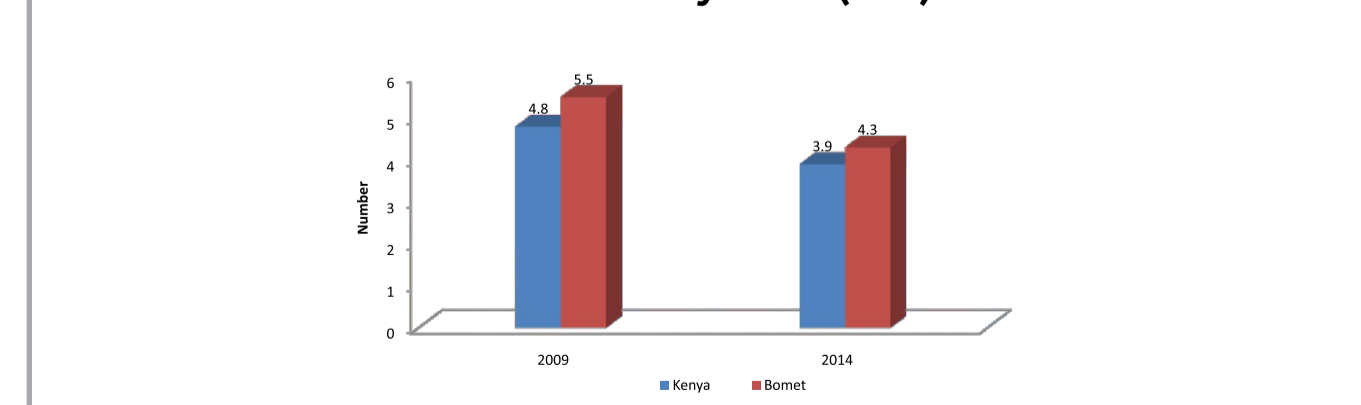

Total Fertility Rates (TFR)

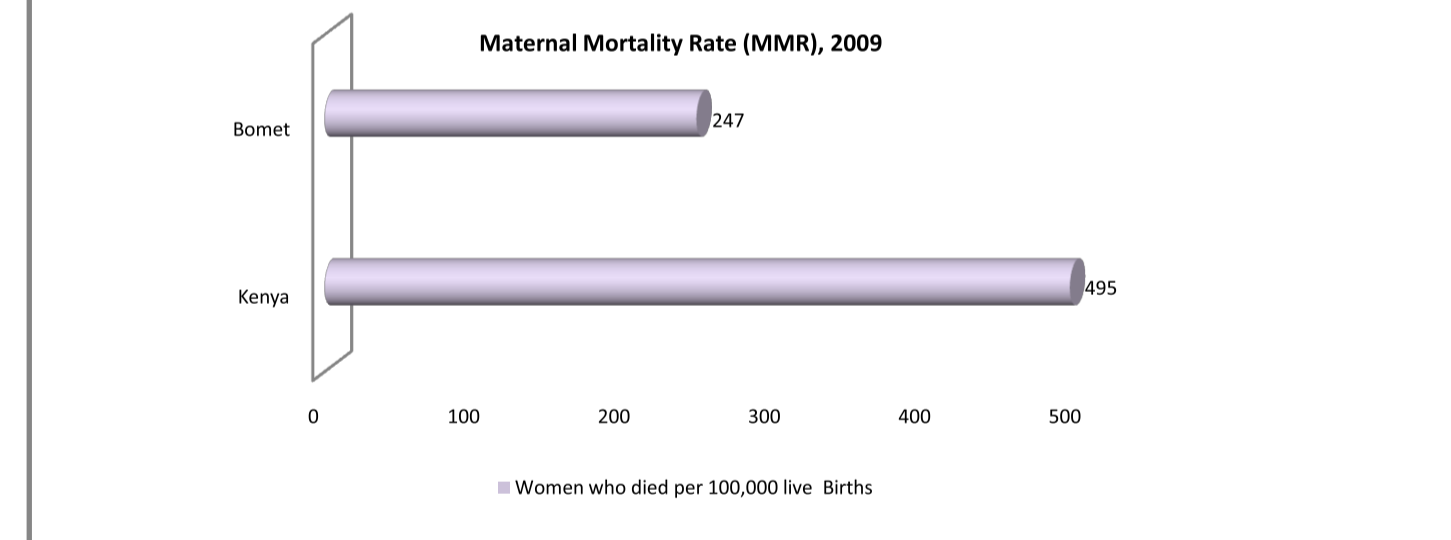


B2: Maternal Mortality Rate (MMR), 2009

Maternal Mortality Rate (MMR), 2009

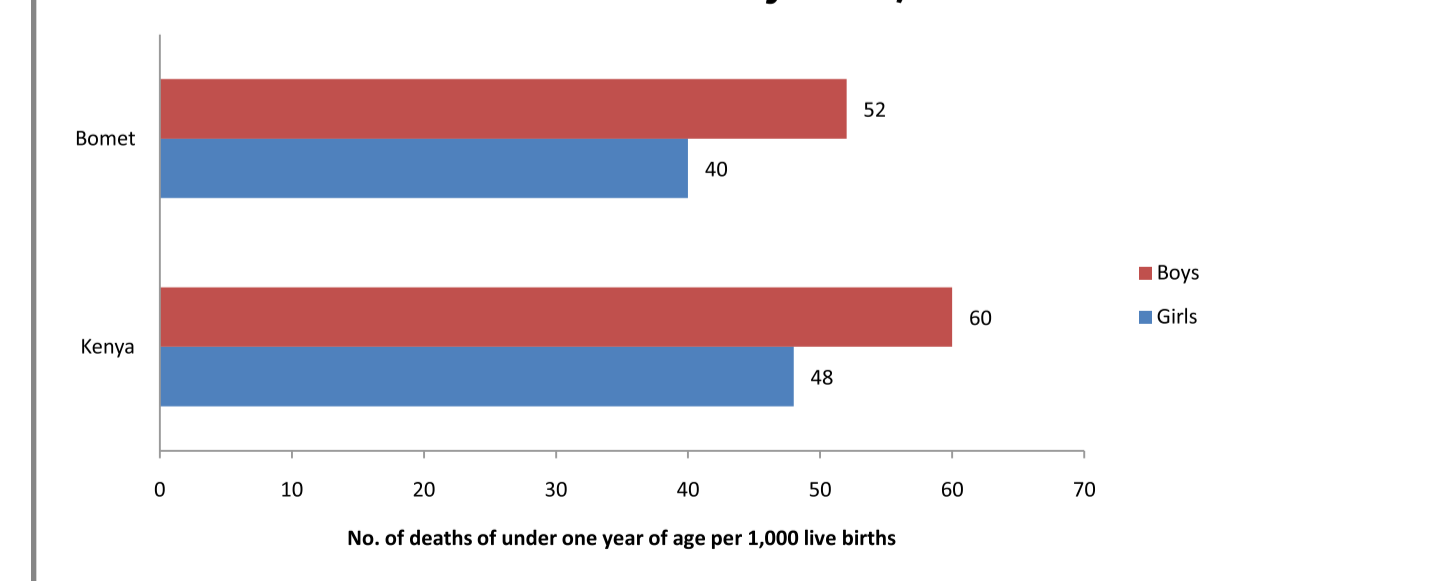


B3: Infant Mortality Rates (IMR)

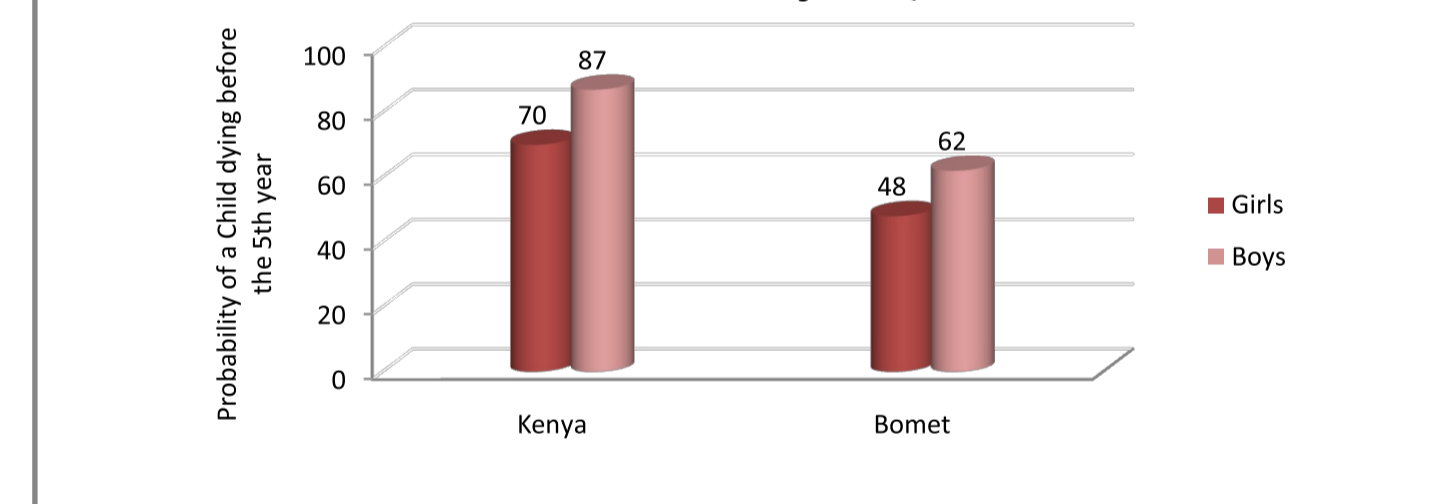

Under 5 Mortality Rate, 2009

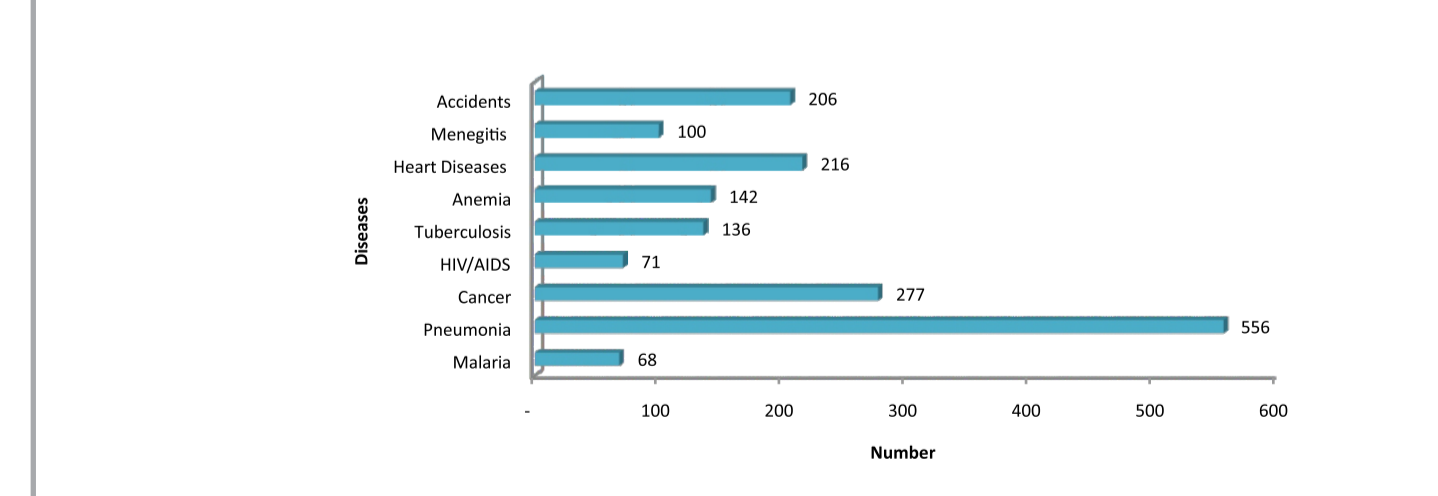

County Major Causes of Deaths 2017



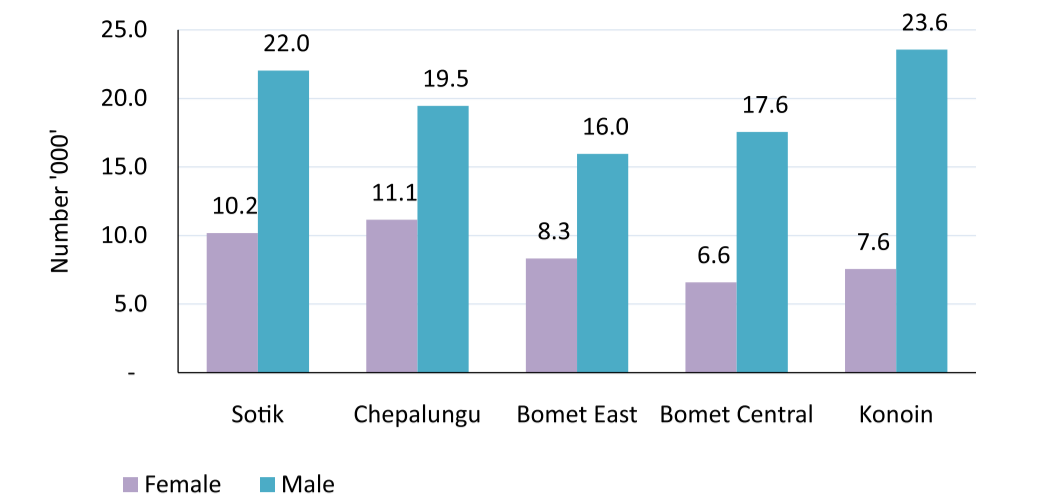

C1: Immunization-Percentage of children aged 12-23 months who received specific vaccines, 2014

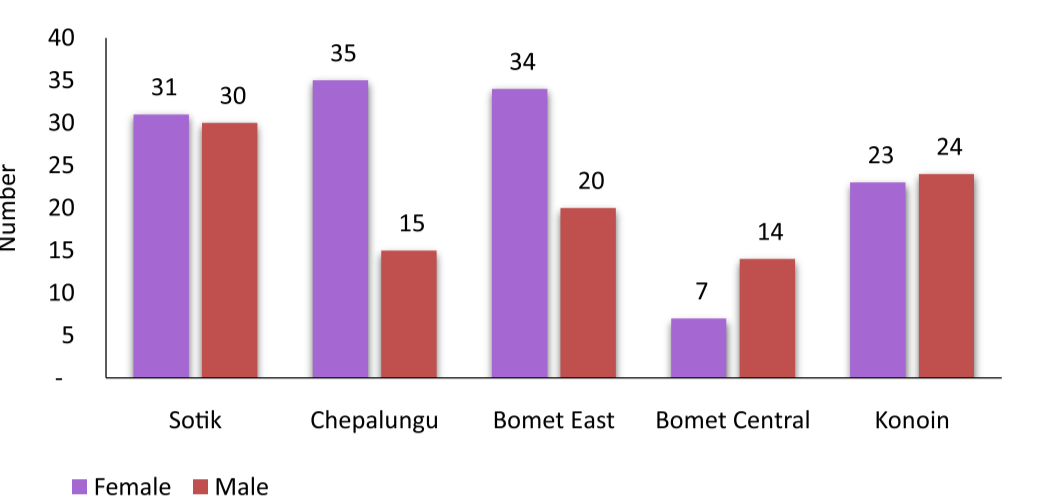

Children Household Leadership by Sub County and Sex

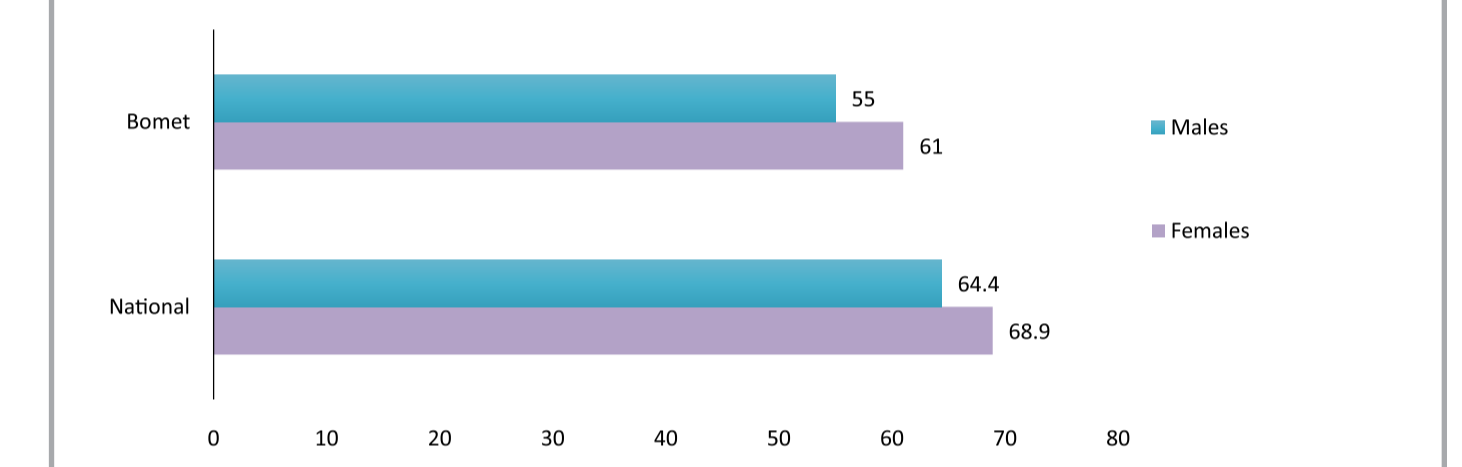

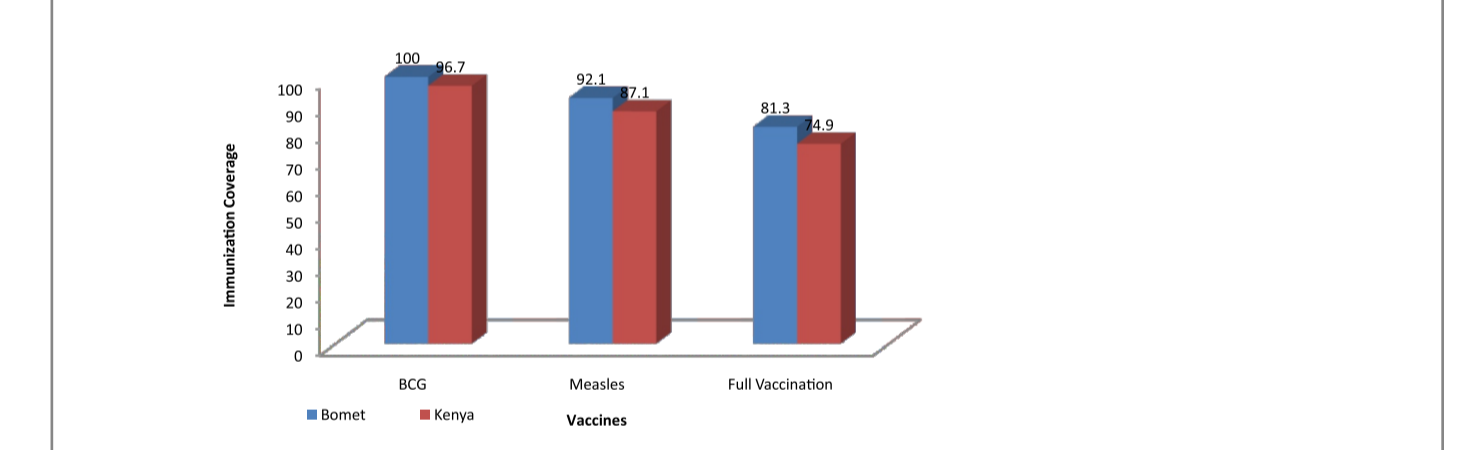

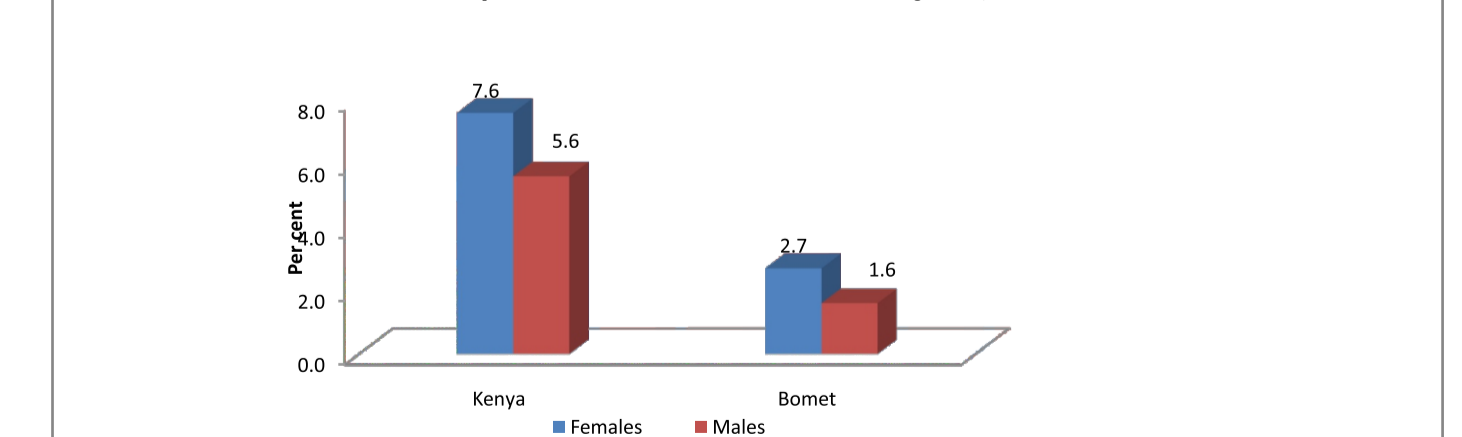

HIV/AIDS Prevalence for Adults 15 - 64 years, 2014

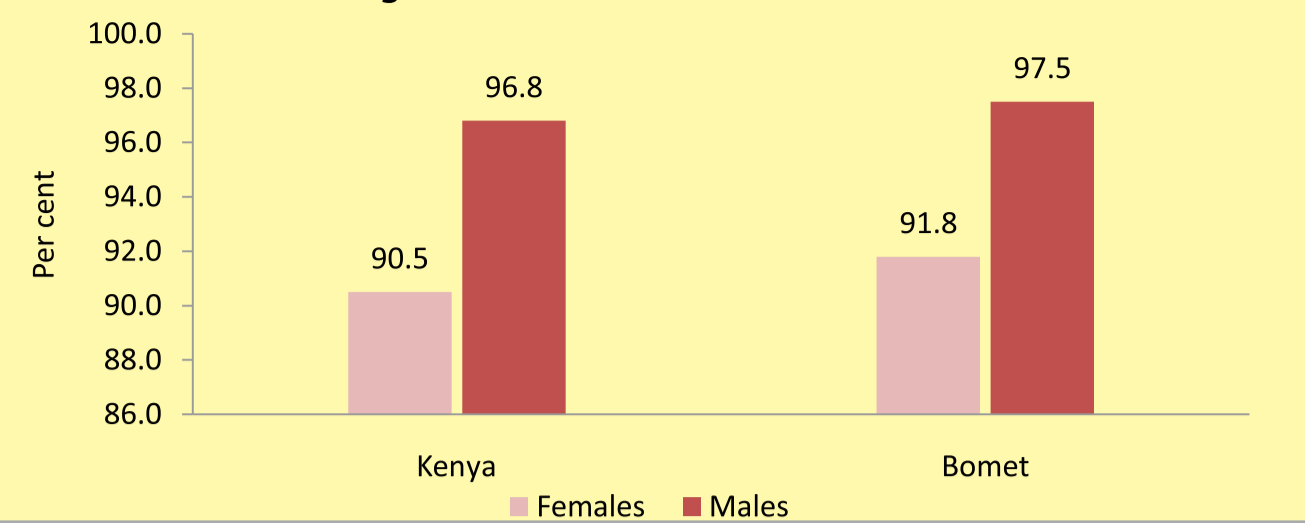


C4: Percentage of Women and Men aged 15-49 who know where to get HIV/AIDS test, 2014

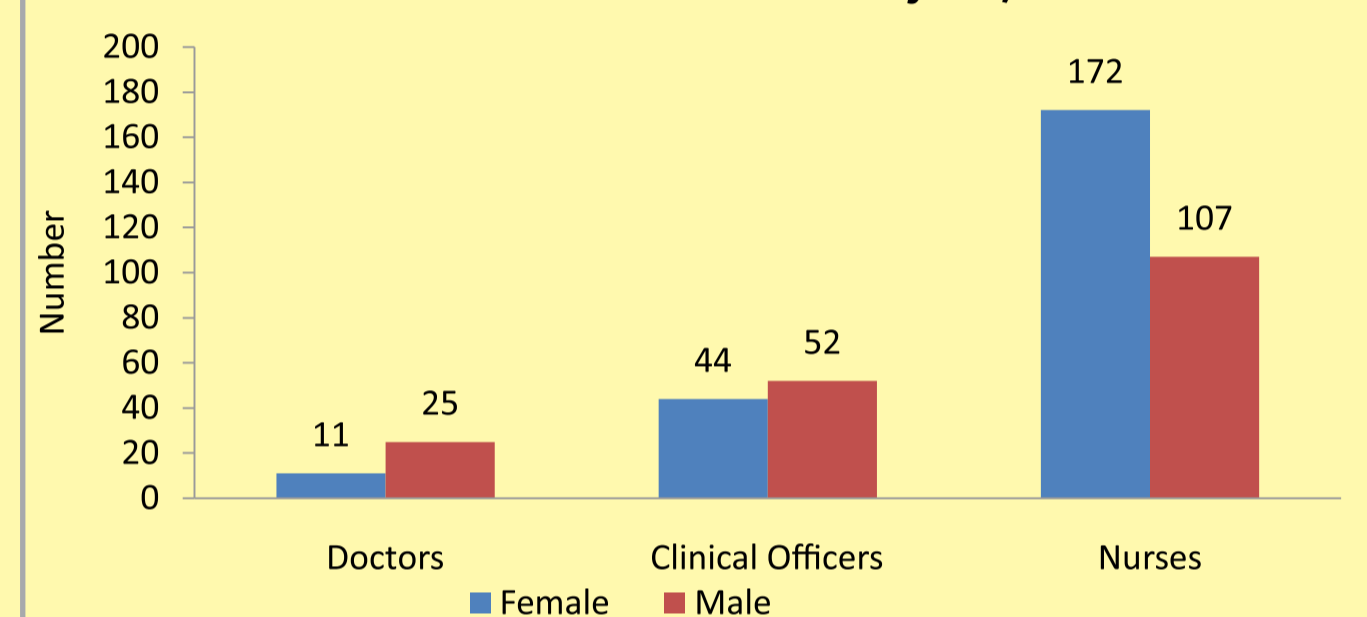

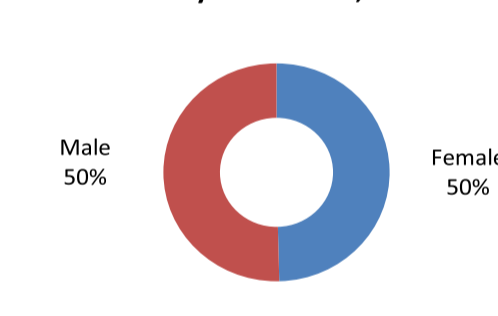

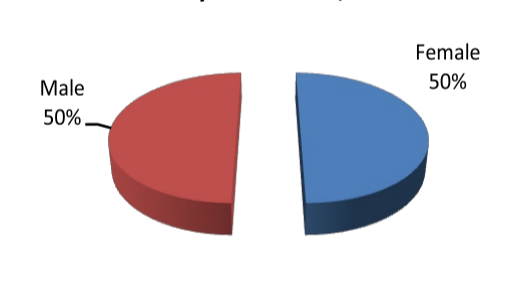
Distribution of Health Personnel by Sex, 2017

Proportion of Women Employees (PWDs) in County Government, 2017

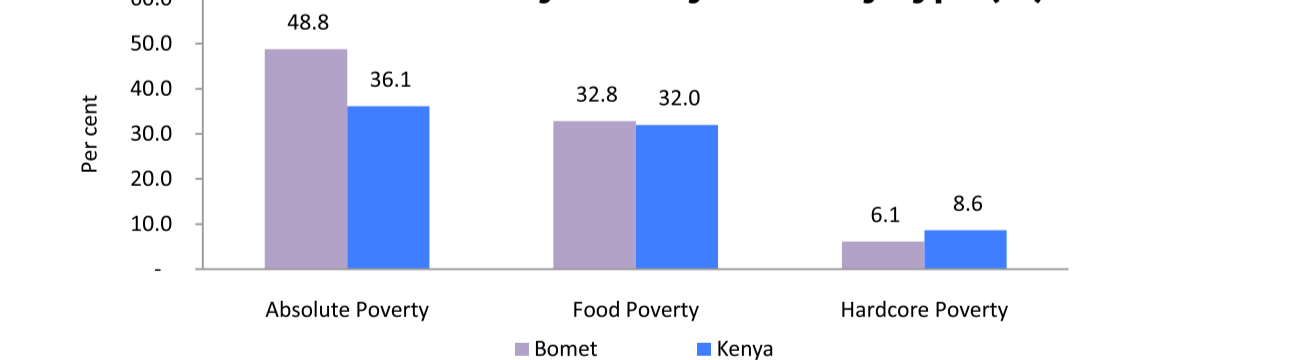

County Poverty Levels by Type (%)

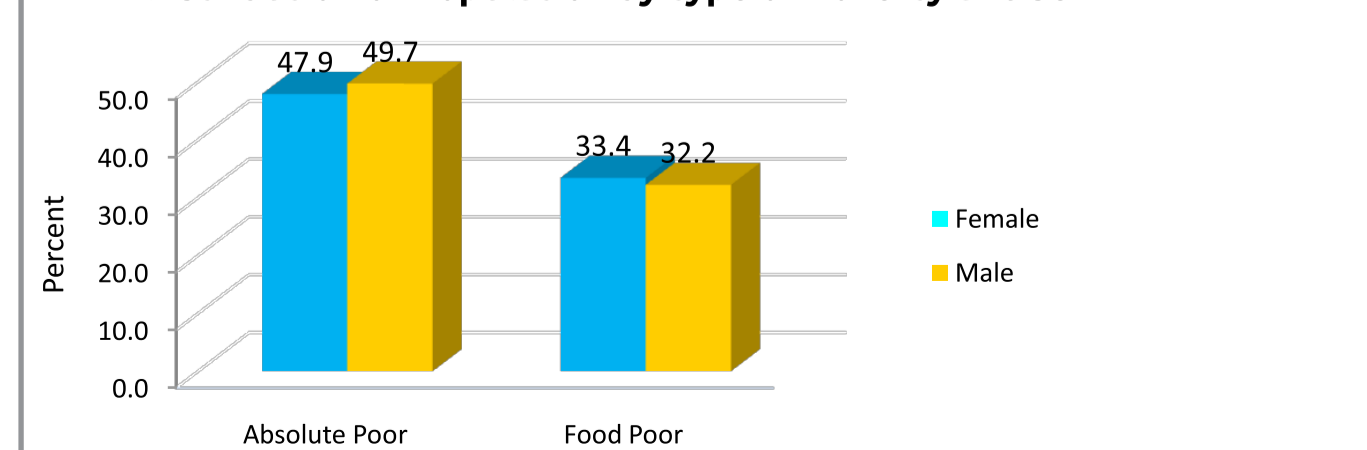


E3: Distribution of Population by type of poverty and sex (%)

Distribution of Population by type of Poverty and sex



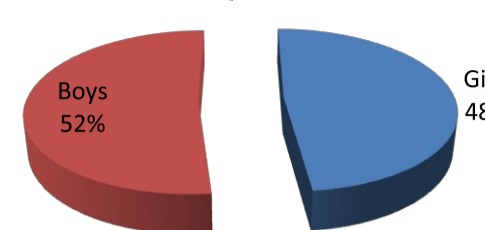

Proportion of County ECDE Enrolment by Sex, 2017

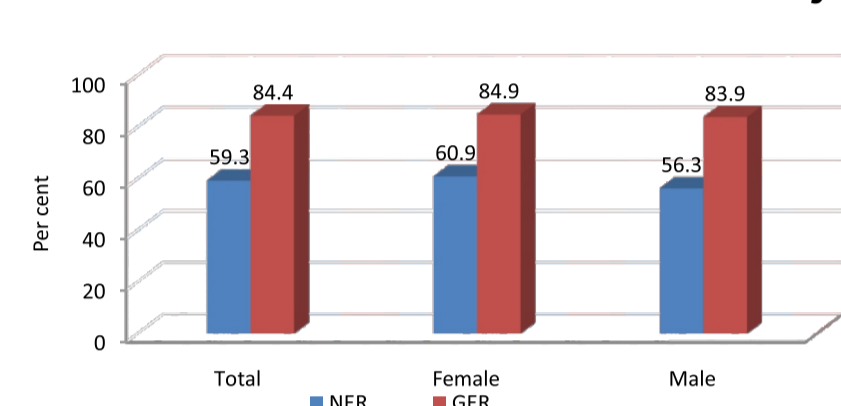

ECDE Gross and Net Enrolment Rates by Sex, 2017

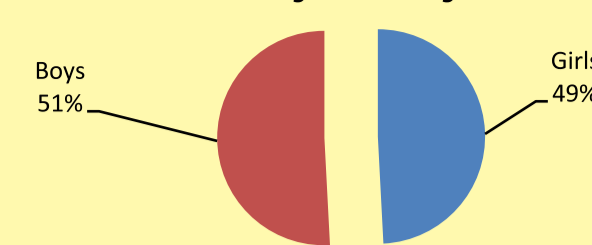

Proportion of County Primary School Enrolment by Sex

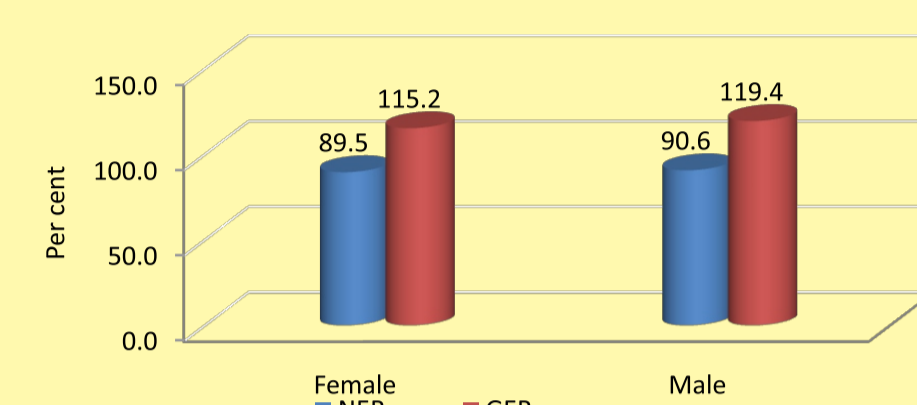


D4: Primary School Gross and Net Enrolment Rates by Sex, 2017

Primary School Gross and Net Enrolment Rates by Sex, 2017

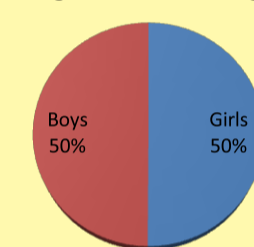

Proportion of County Secondary School Enrolment by Sex

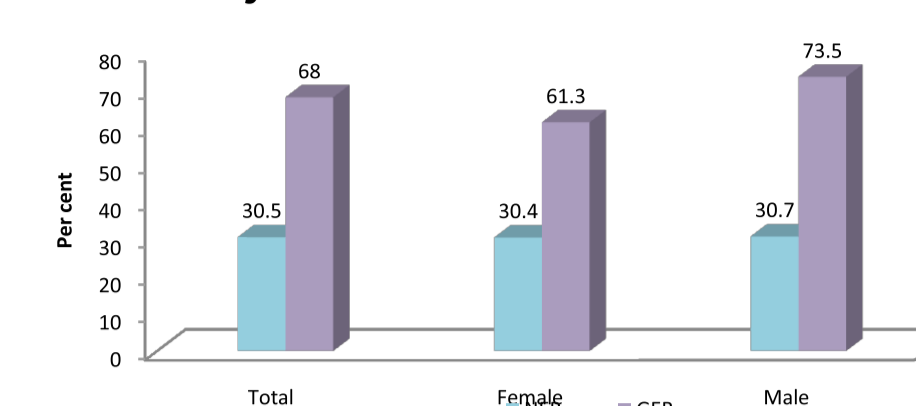


D6: Secondary School Gross and Net Enrolment Rates by Sex, 2017 (%)

Secondary School Gross and Net Enrolment Rates by Sex, 2017

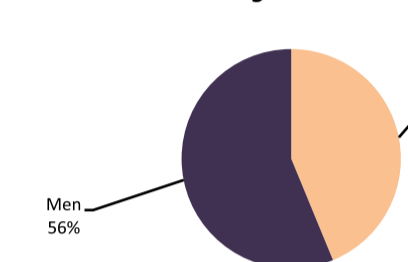

Proportion of County TVET Enrolment by Sex, 2017



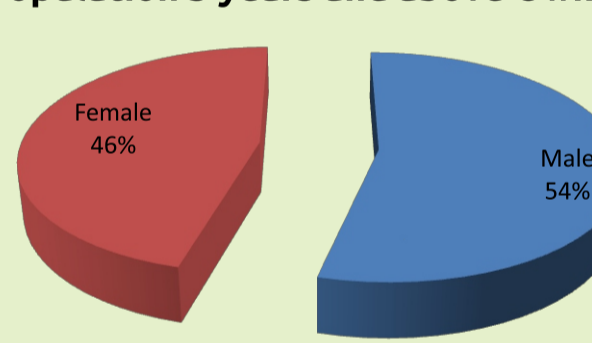

Population 3 years and above Owning Mobile phone



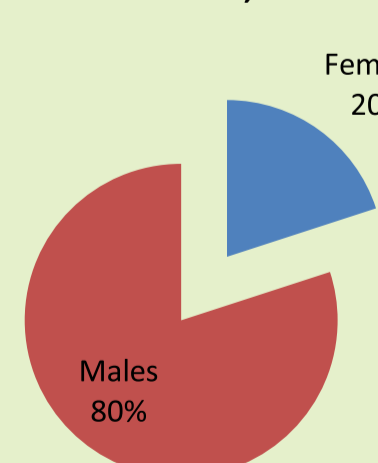

F1: Proportion of County Women in legislative arm of National and County Governments

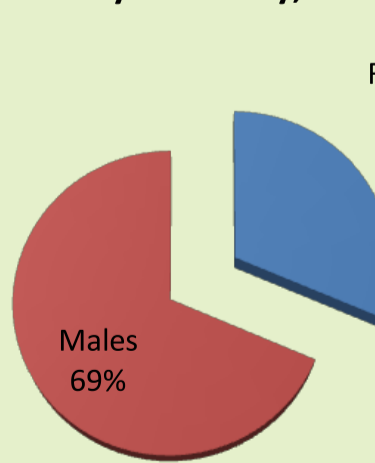

Proportion of Women in the Parliament, 2017



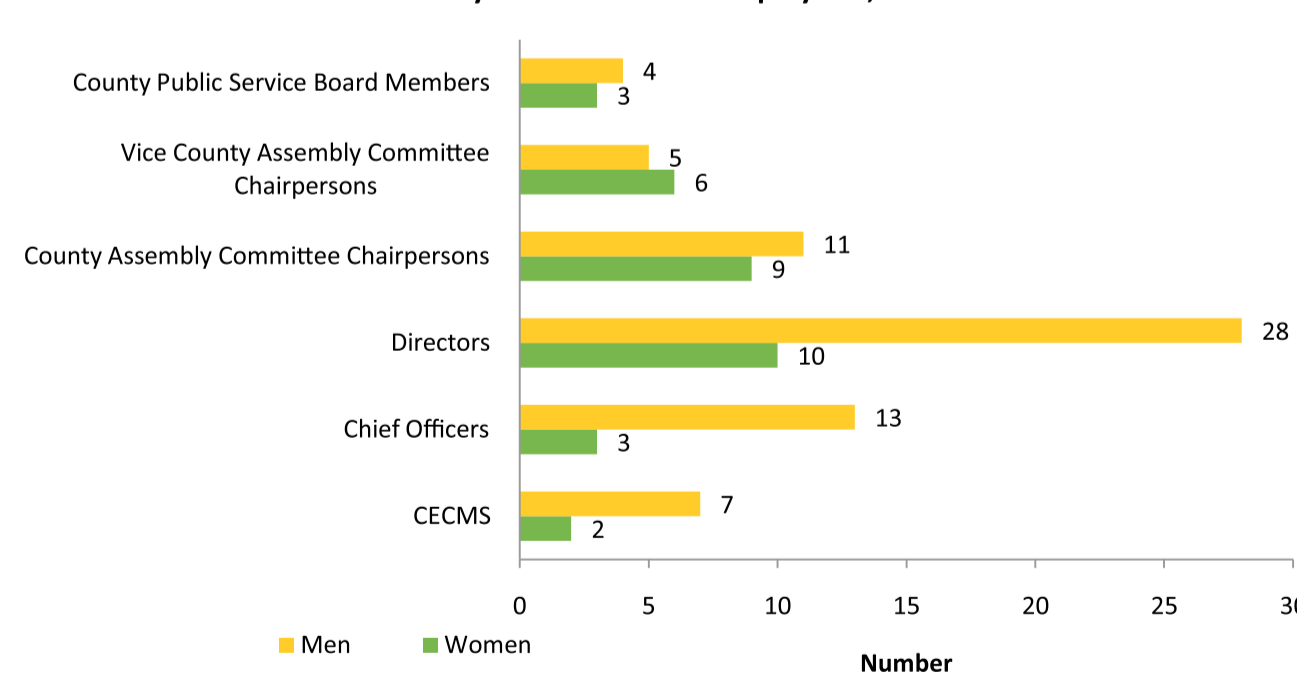
Proportion of Women in the County Assembly, 2017

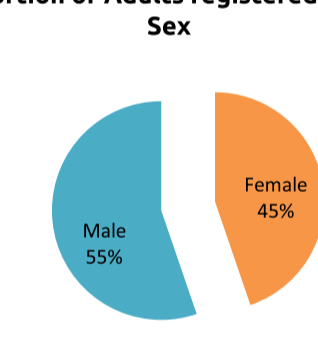

Proportion of Adults registered as Voters by Sex

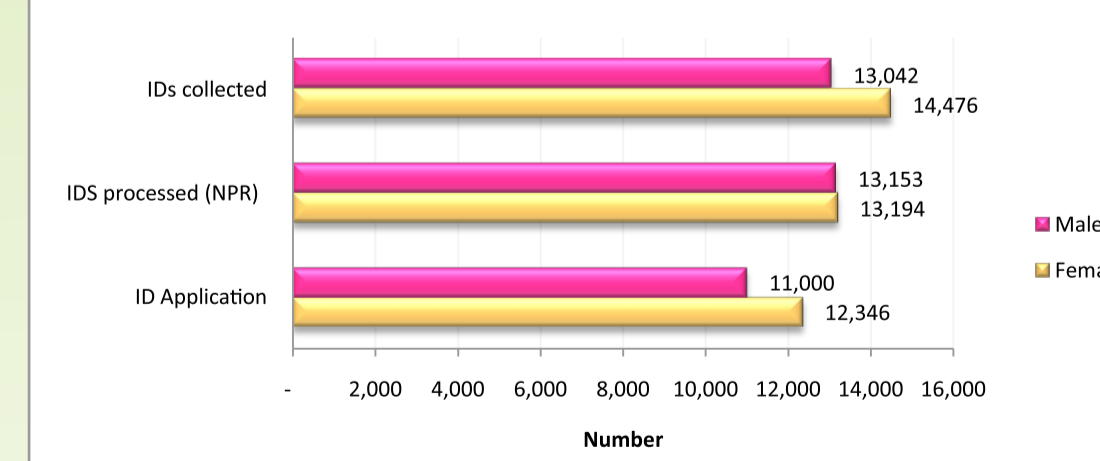
