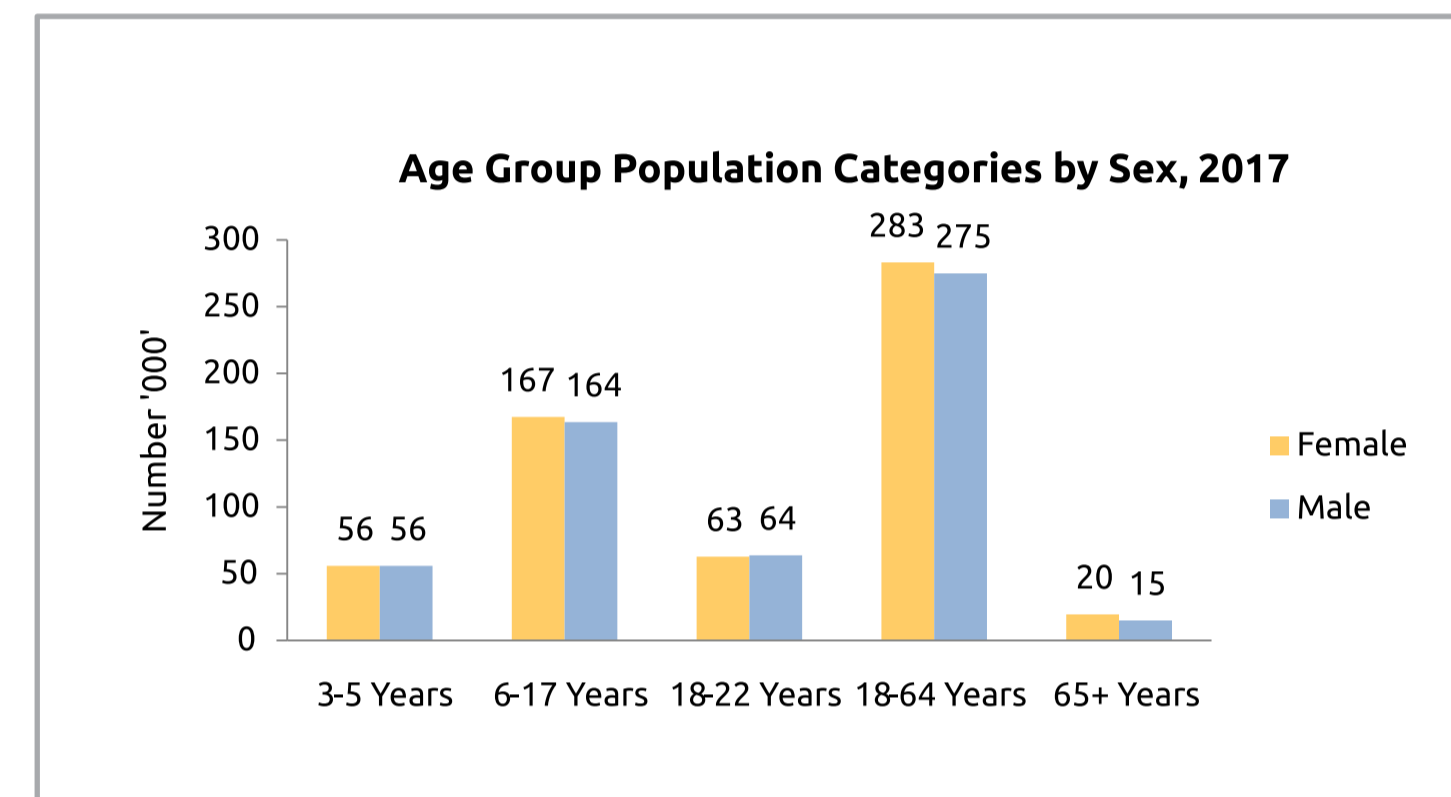

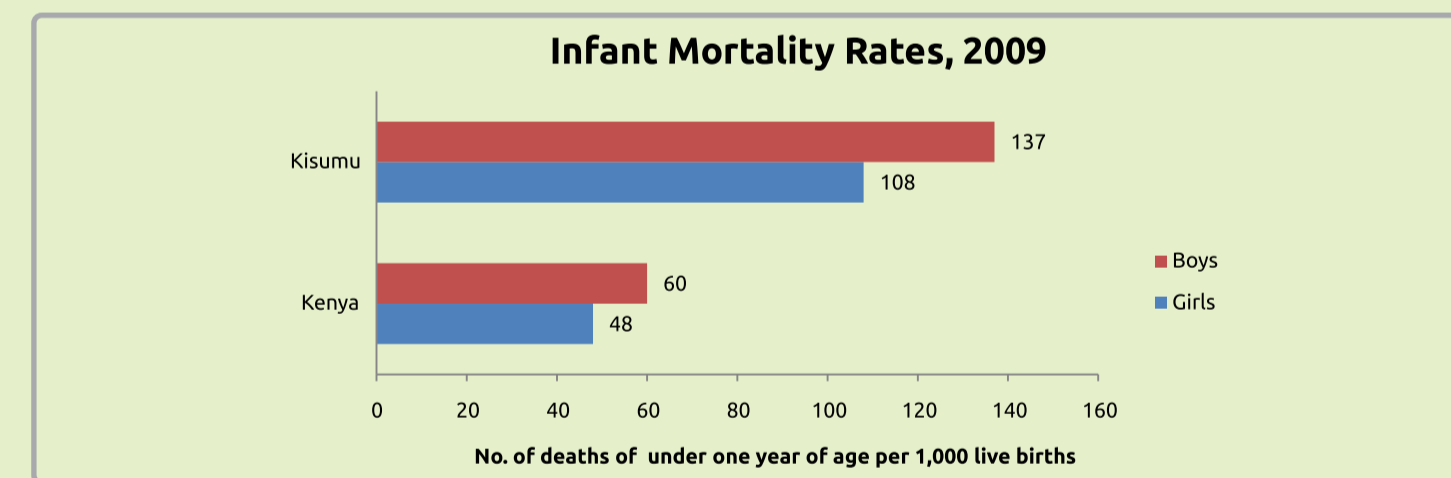
#### A3: Age Group Population Categories by Sex, 2017

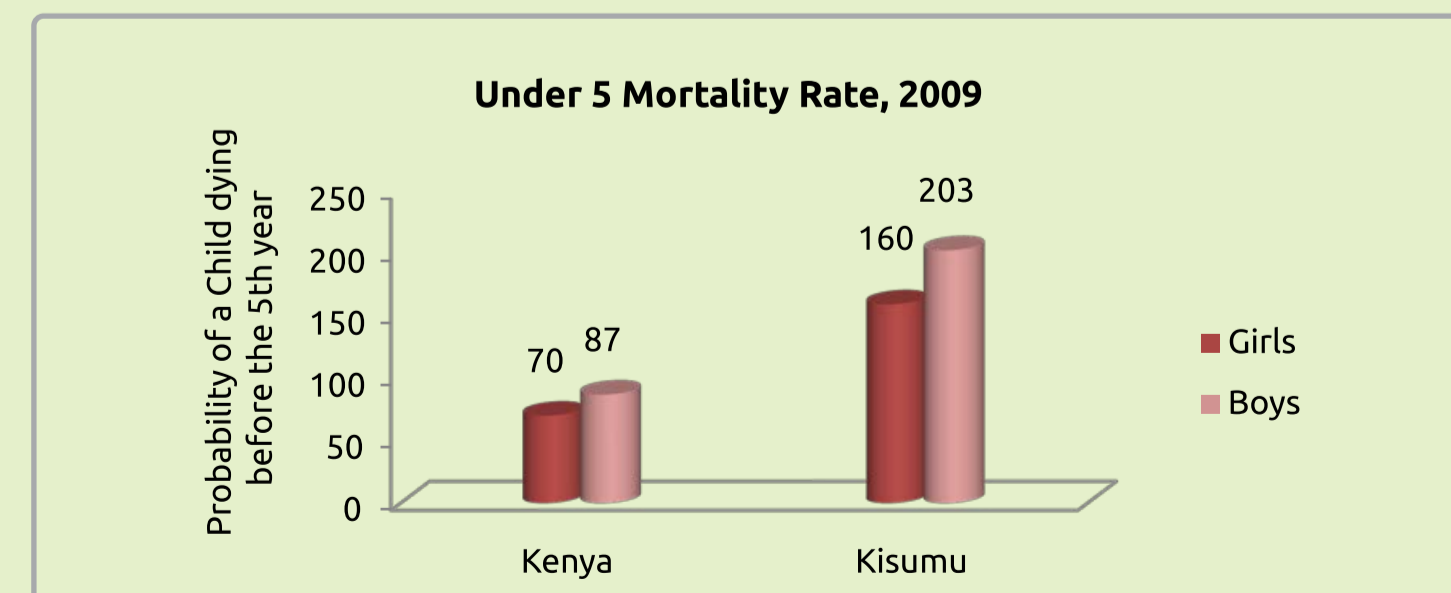

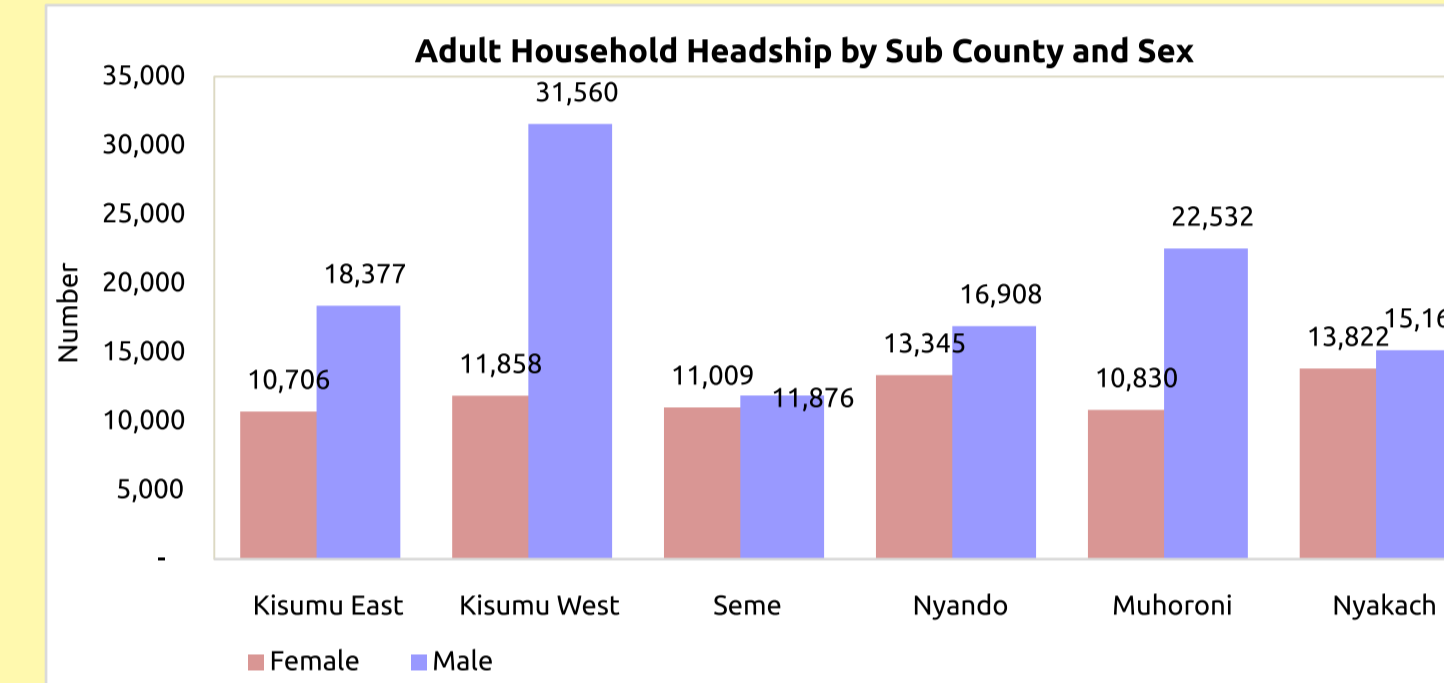

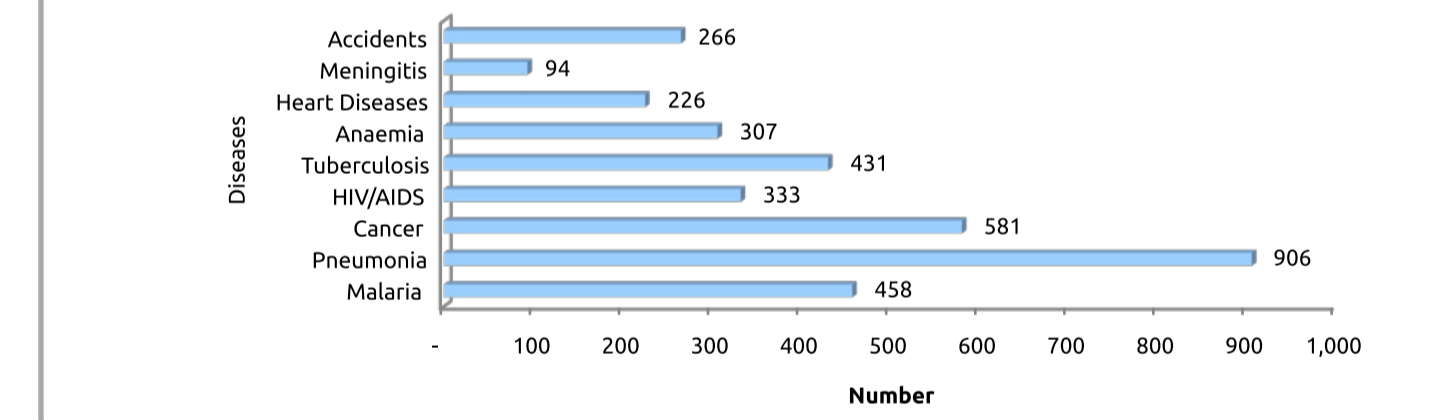

#### County Major Causes of Deaths, 2017

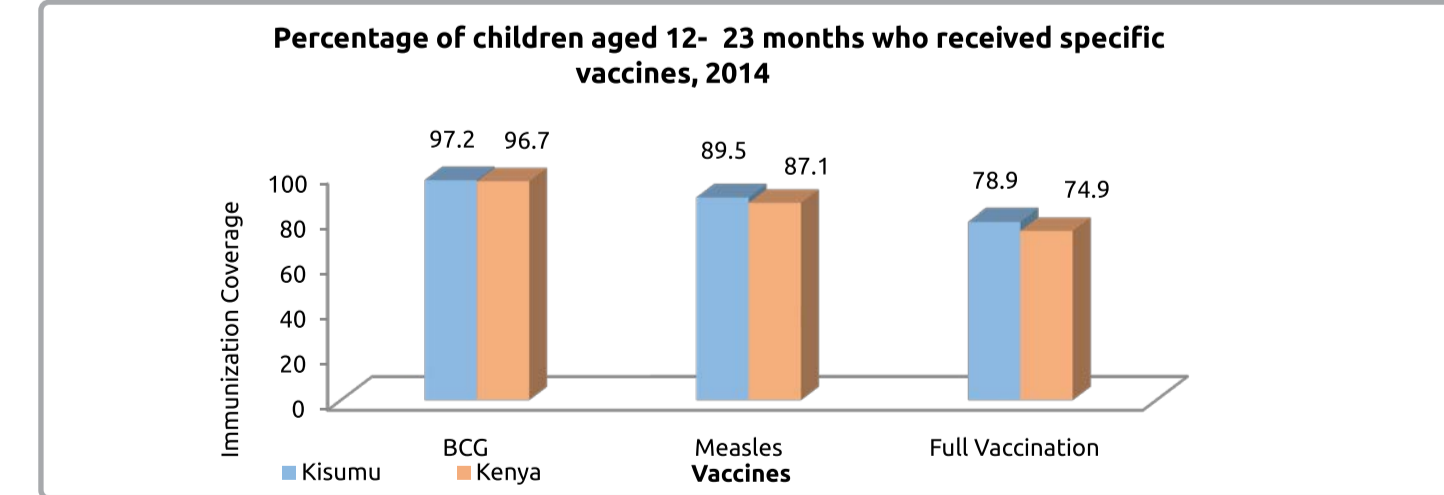

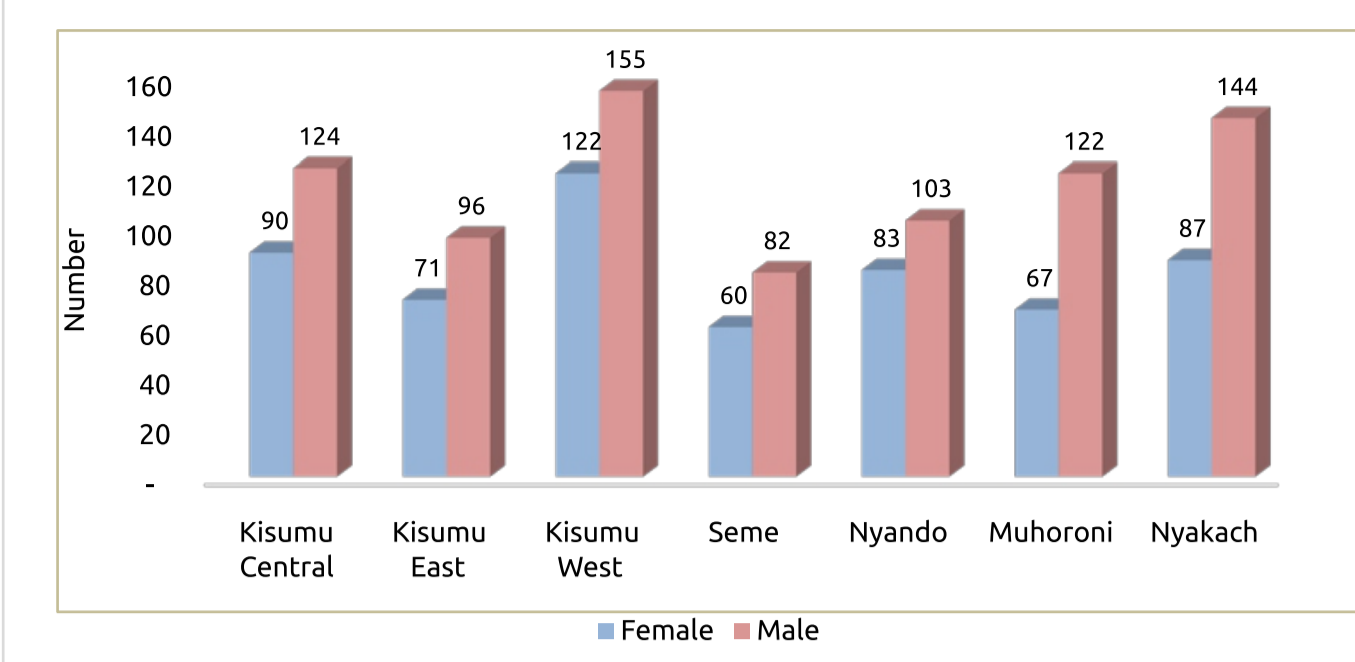

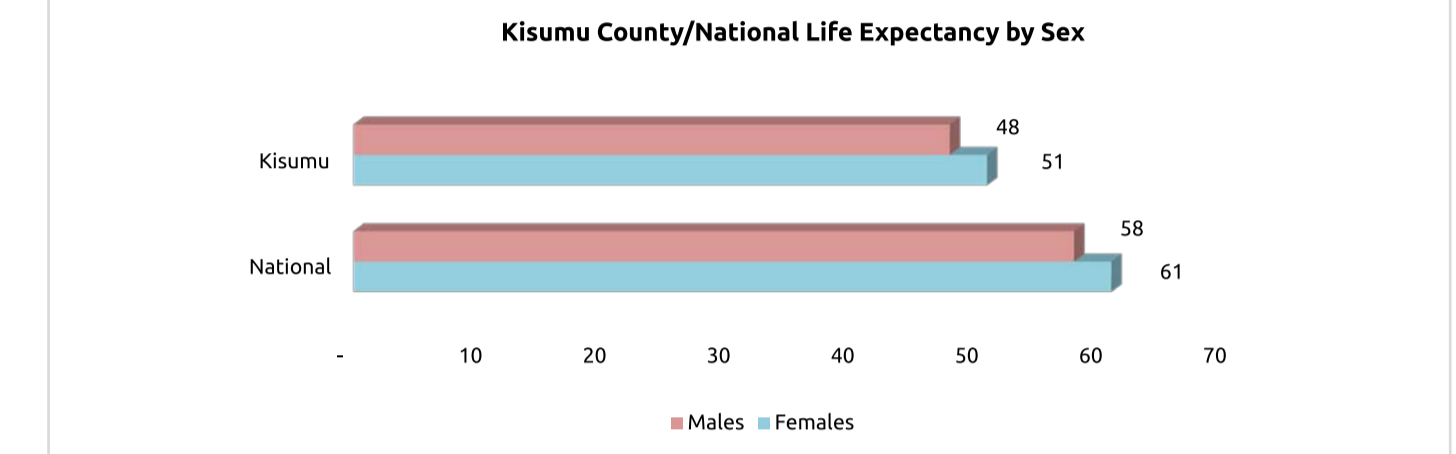
#### Children Household Headship by Sub County and Sex

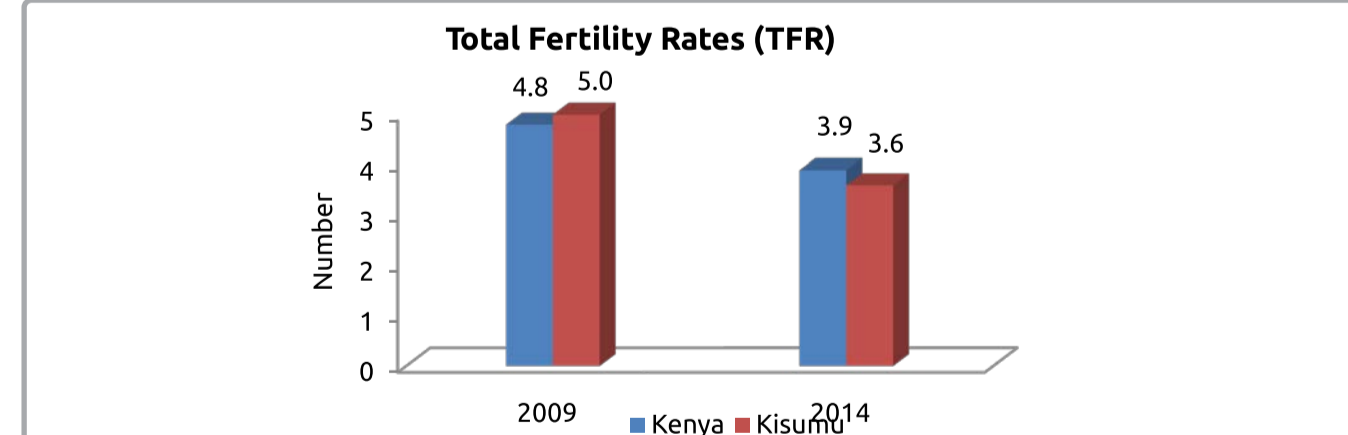

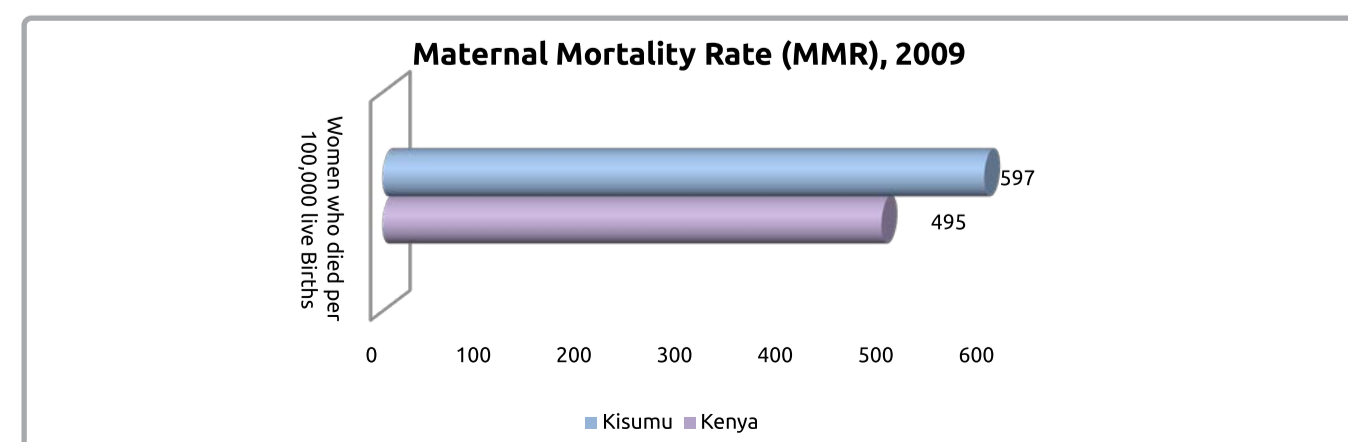

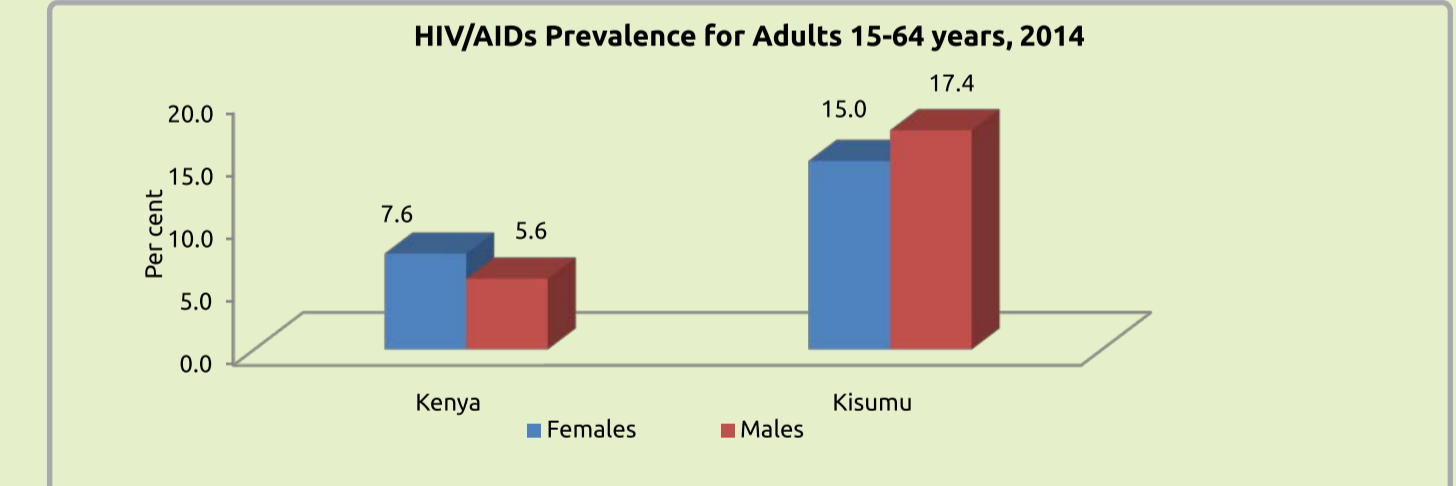

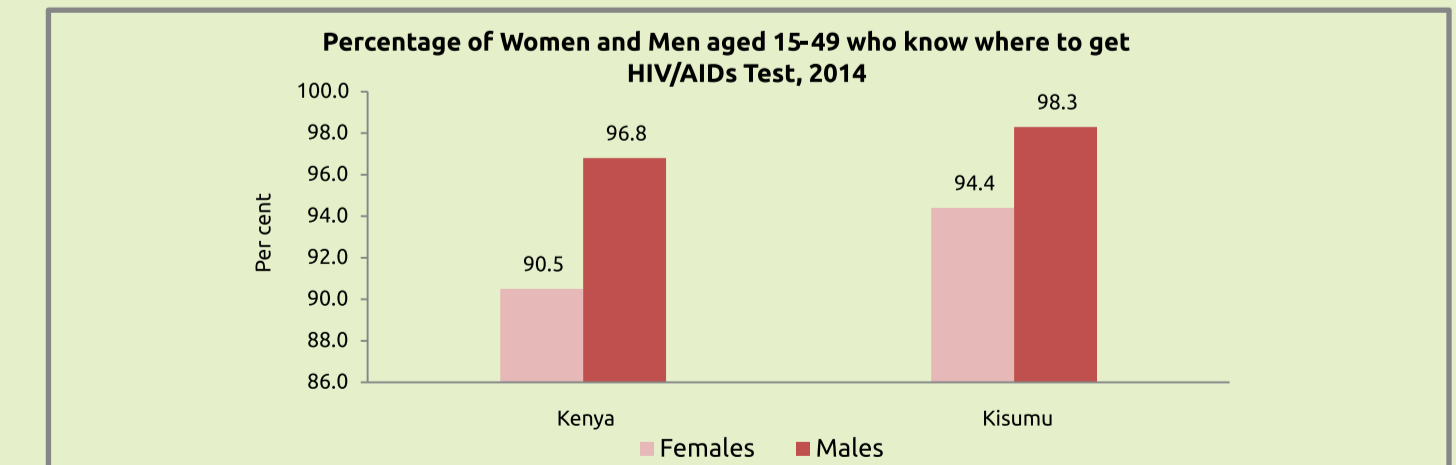

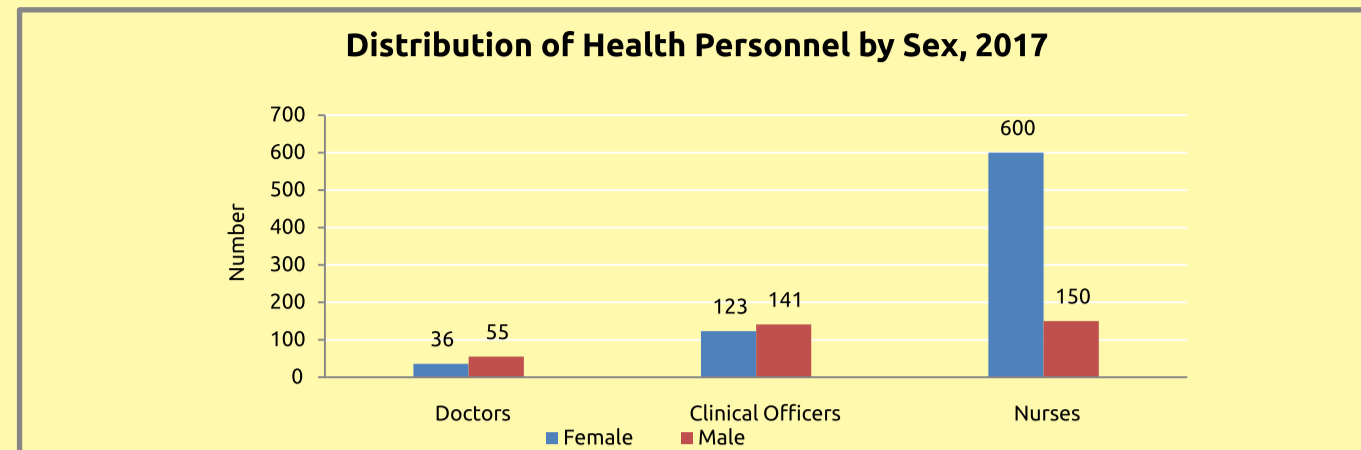

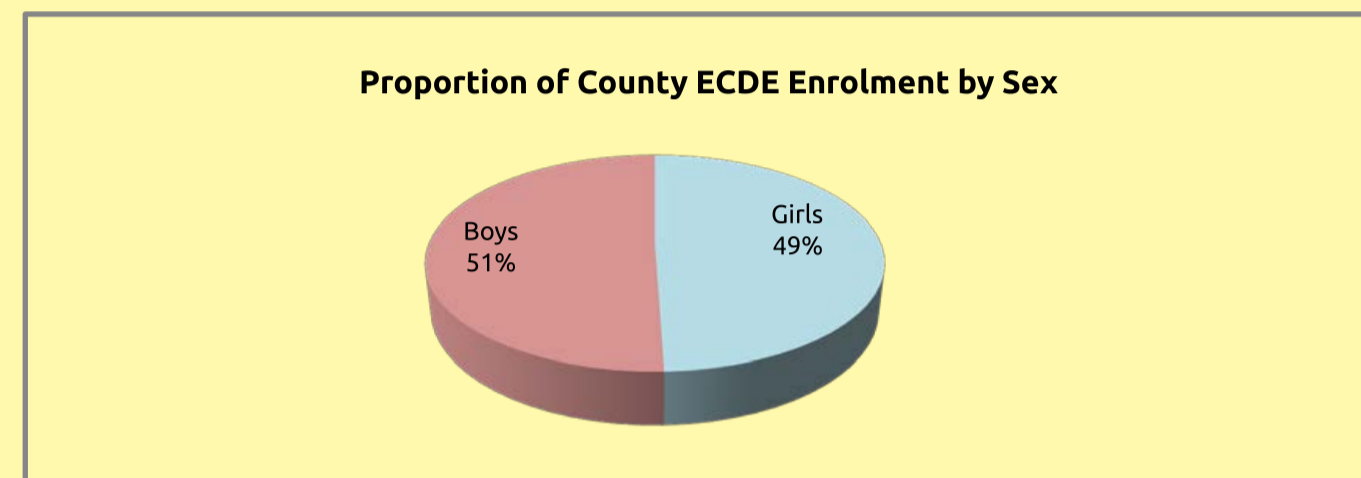

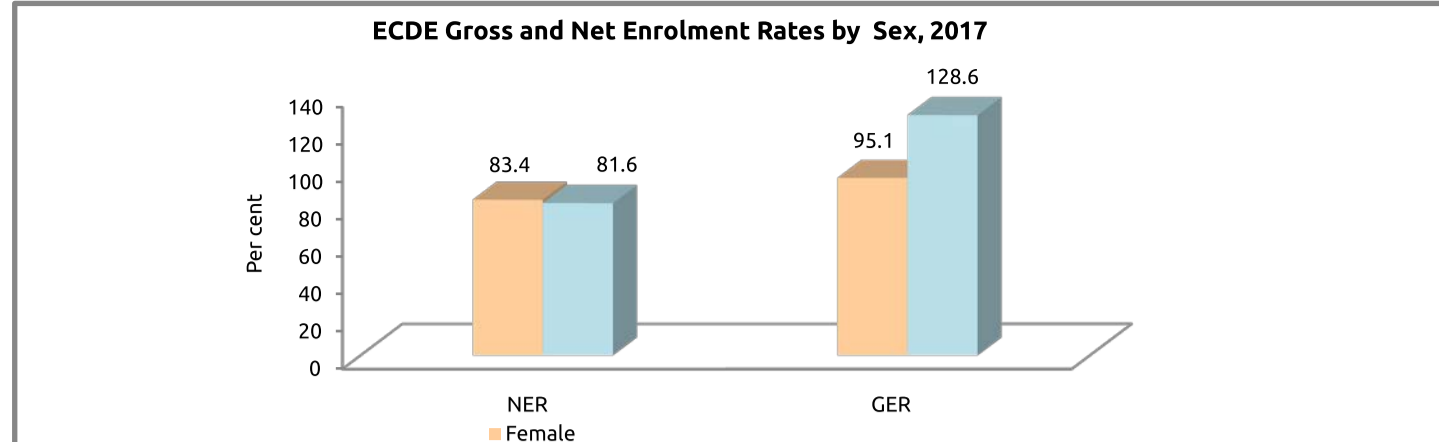

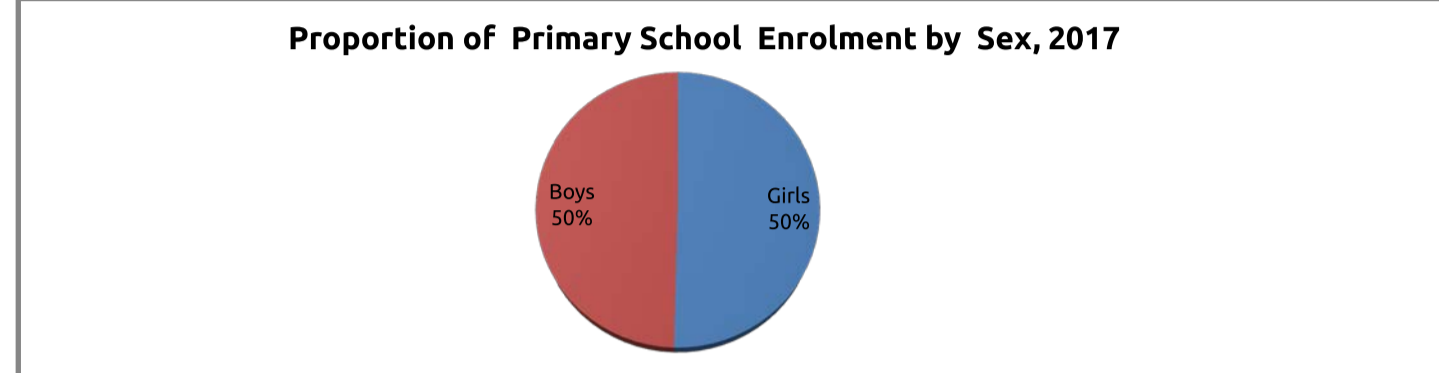

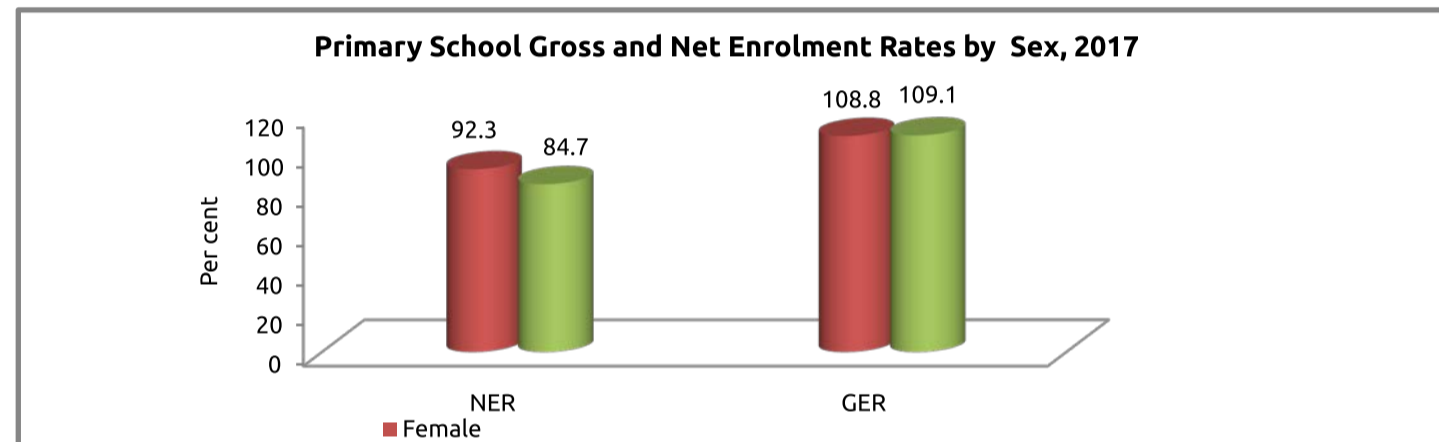

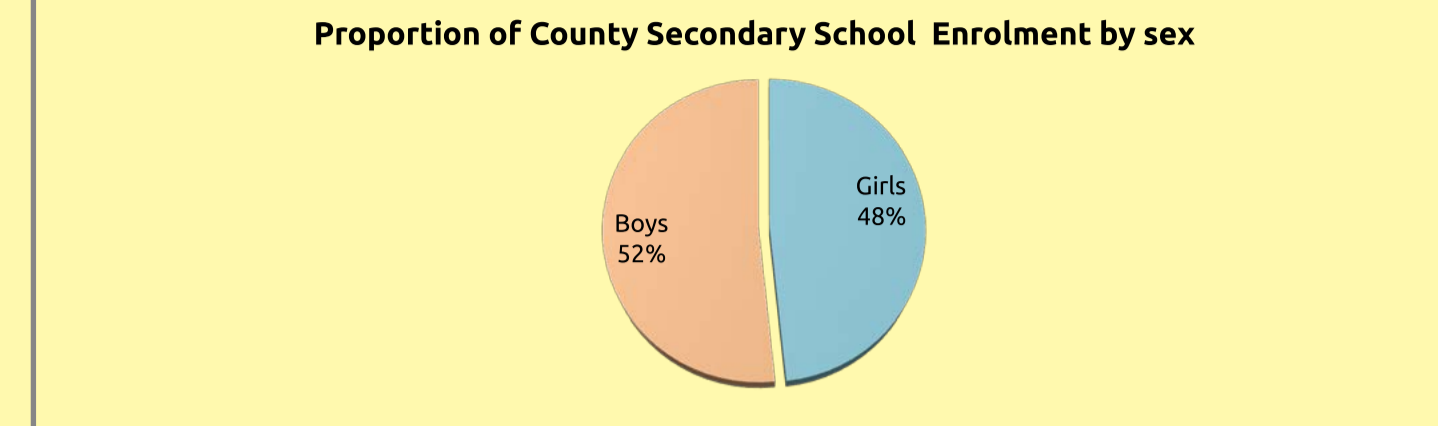

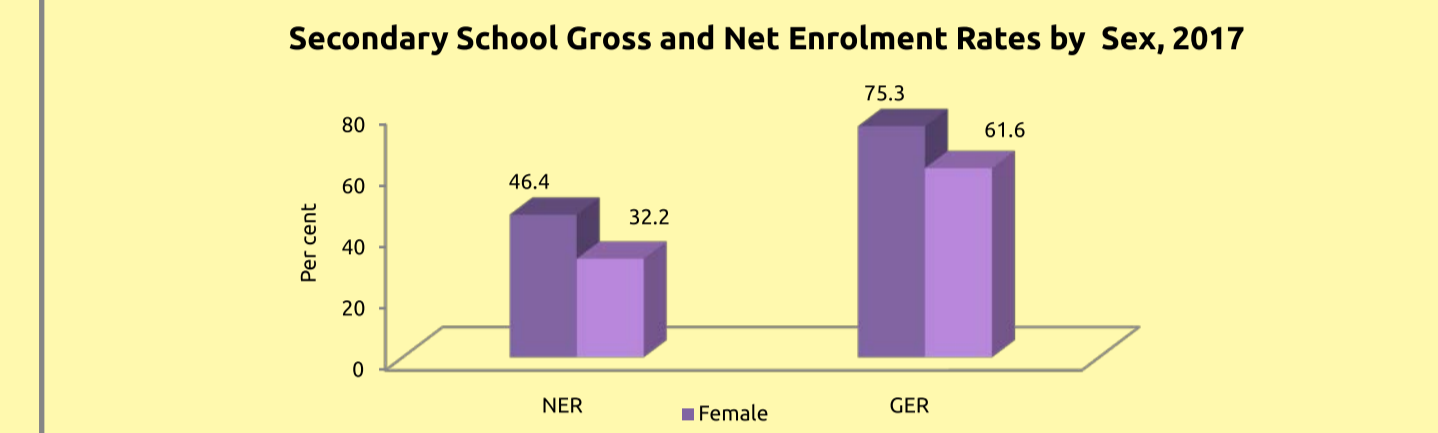

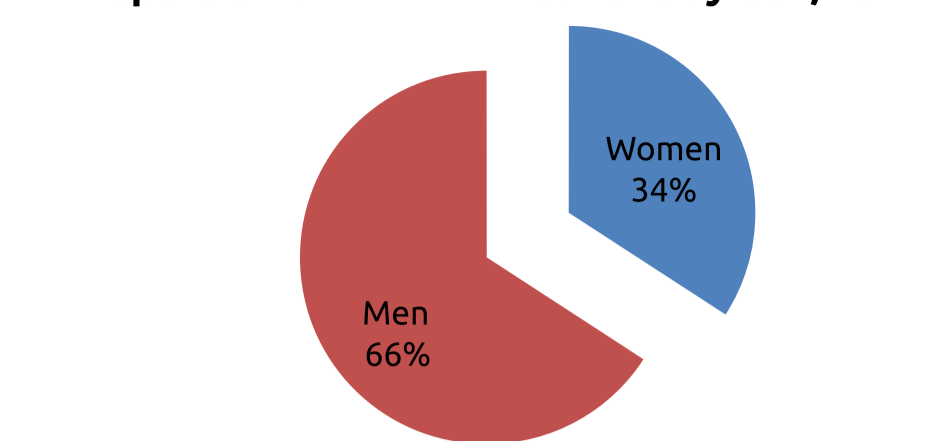

**Proportion of TVET Enrolment by Sex, 2017**

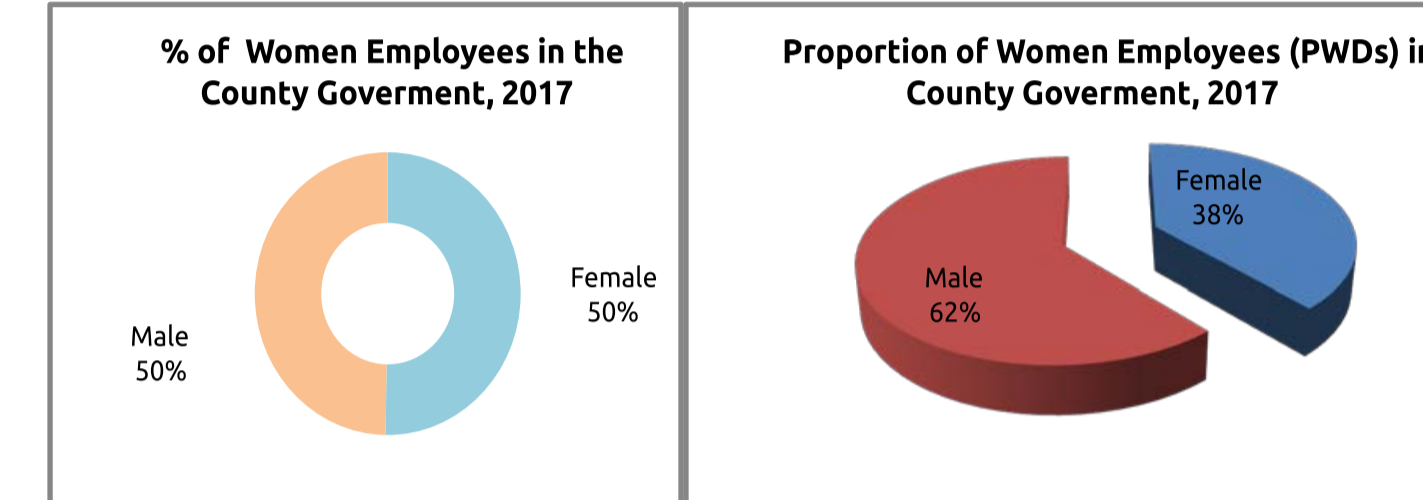

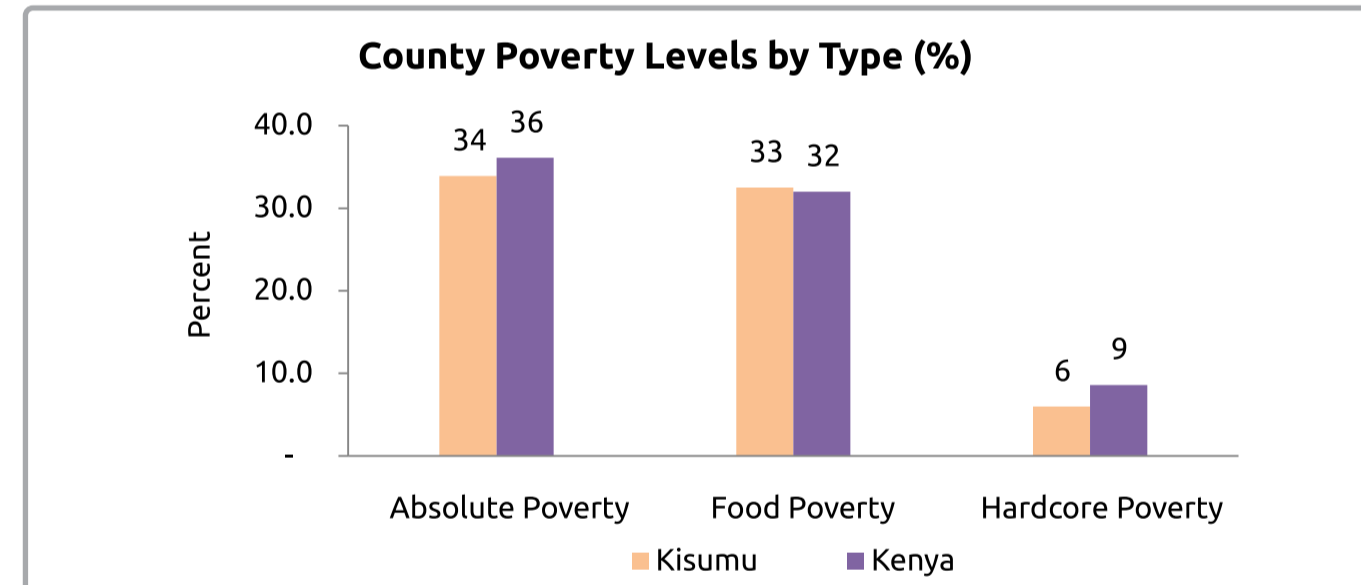

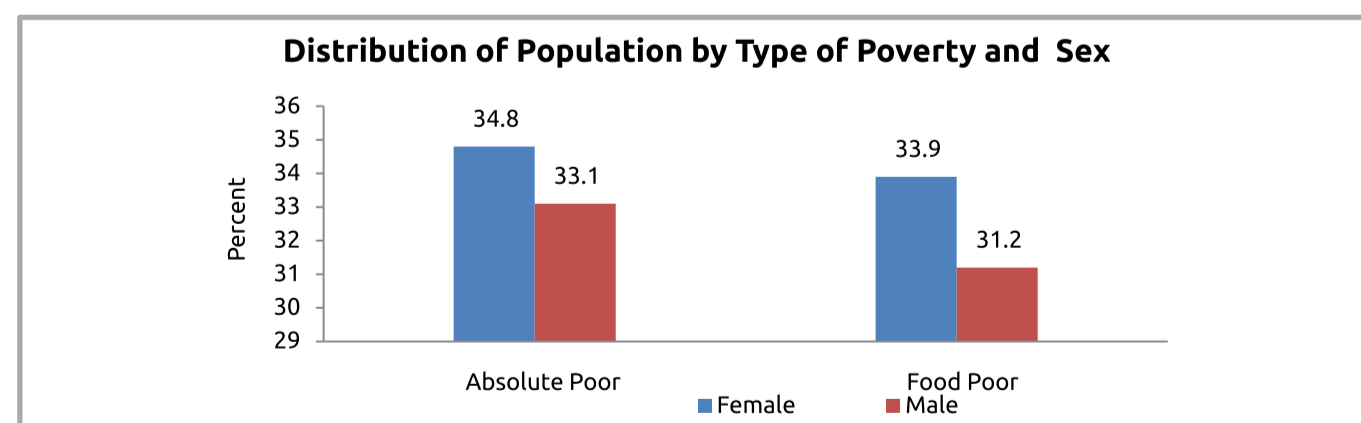

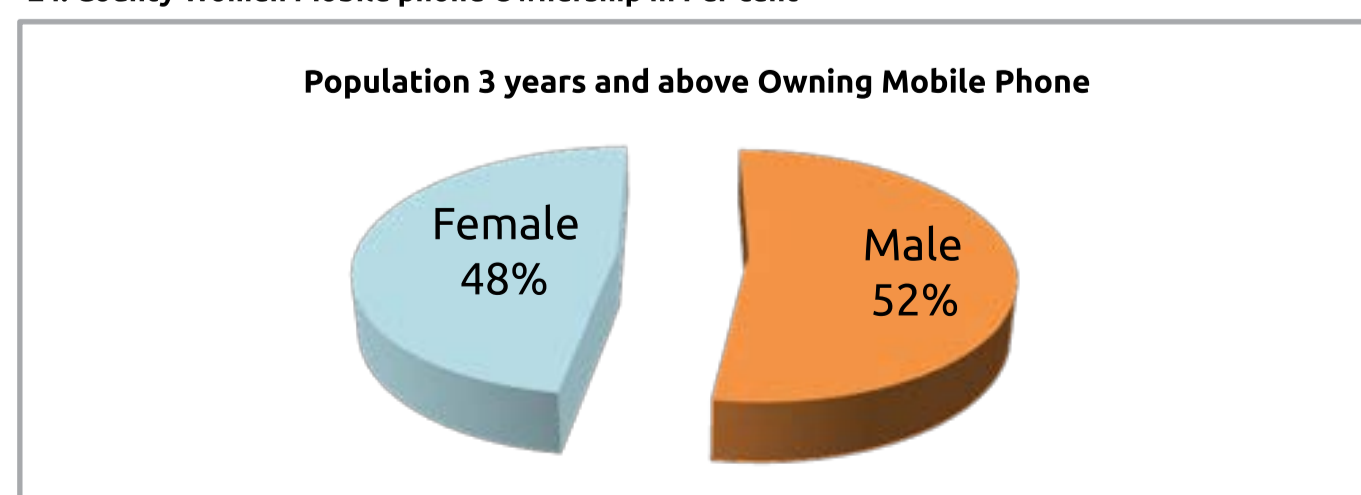
**E3: Distribution of Population by Type of Poverty and Sex (%)**

**E4: County Women Mobile phone Ownership in Per cent**

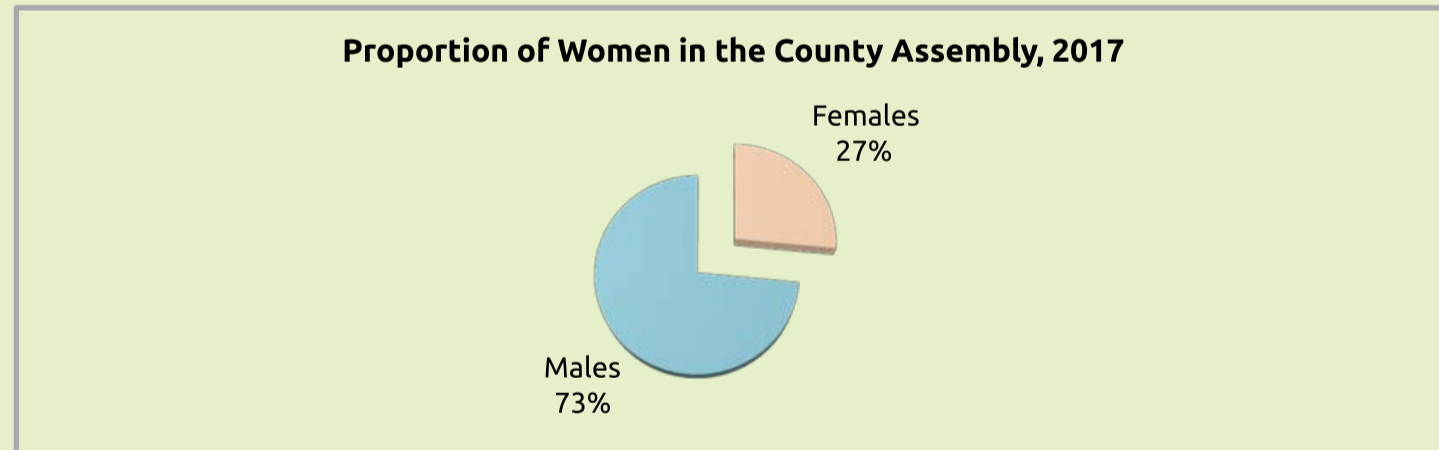

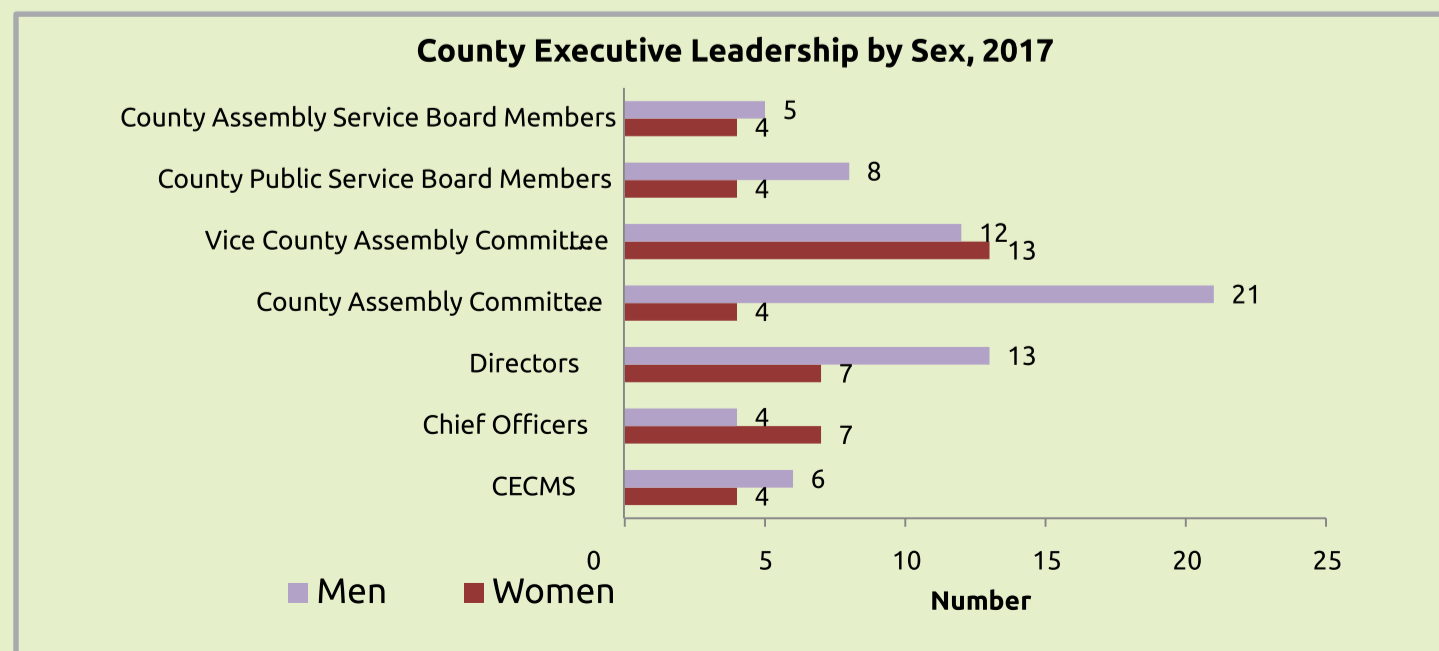

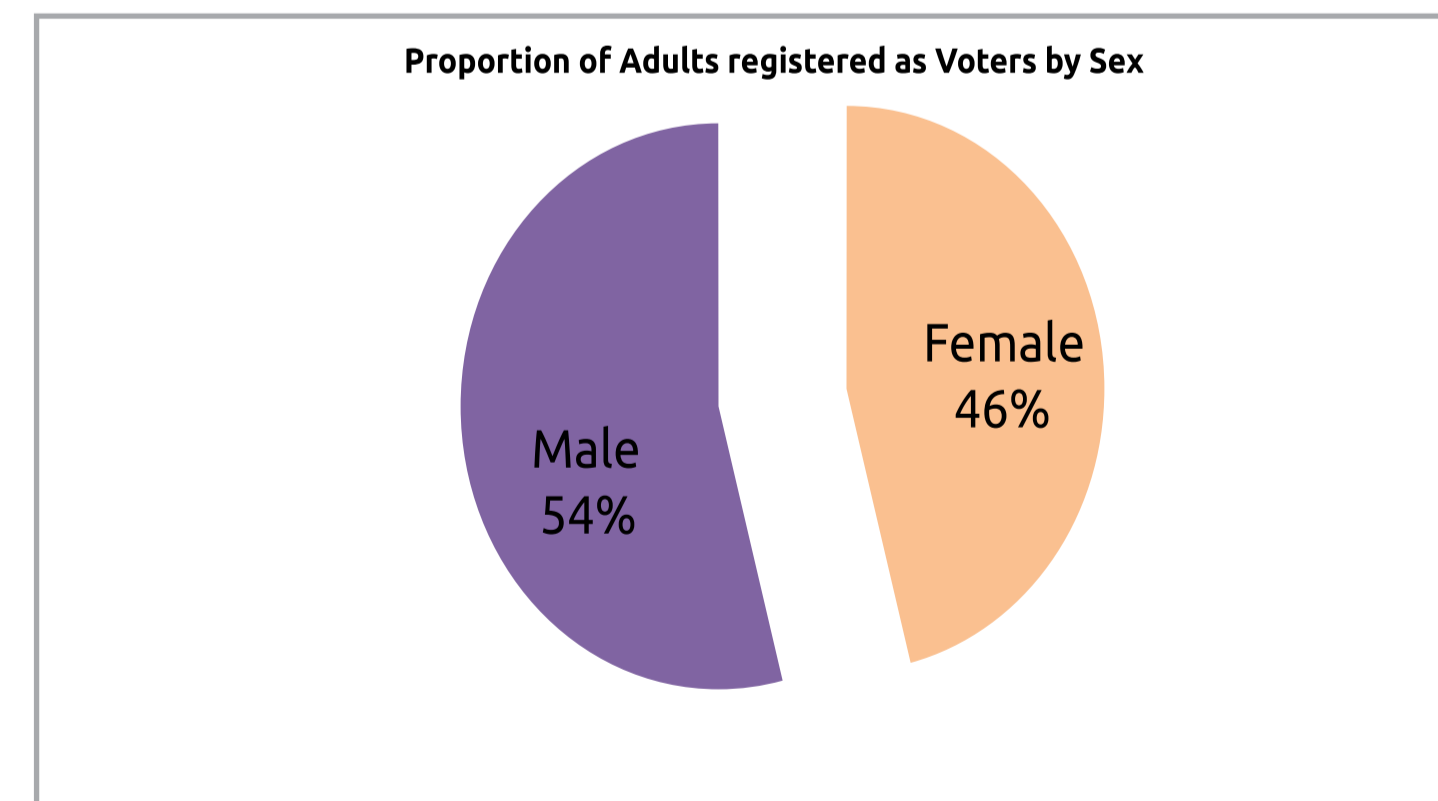

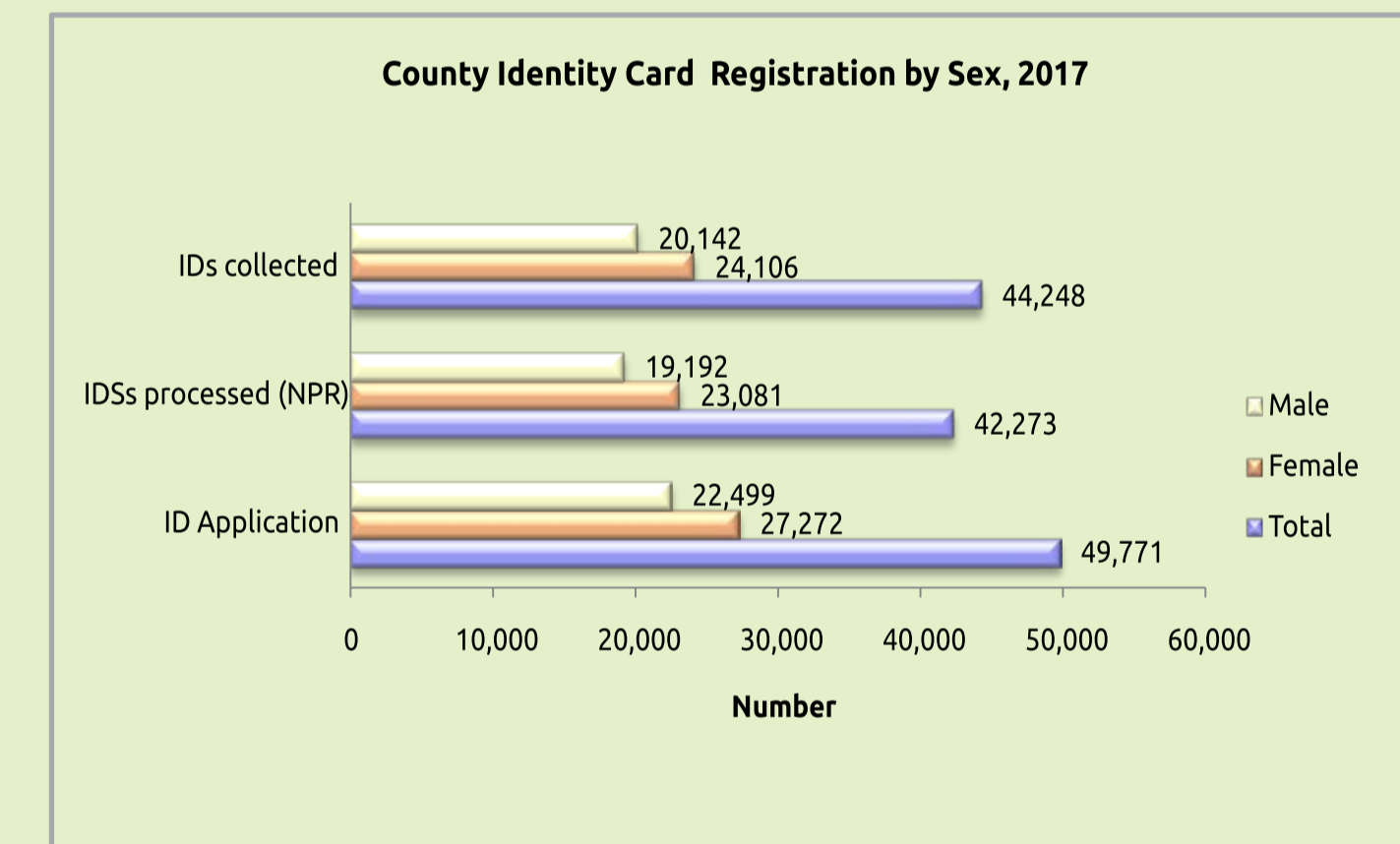
